USA Meets:

You must be USA registered to swim at USA meets. Sign ups for these meets will be on the team website.

~Please note there are event fees for USA meets. You must pay for your event fees at the YMCA front desk before the entry deadline. There are no fees for relays.

We encourage everyone on Green, Gold, and Black group to be USA registered. If its your child's first time registering for USA swimming you must provide a copy of your child's birth certificate.

~Timers will be needed. Timing at USA meets will be assigned to families attending these meets. Please note you will be notified by email if you are required to time.

Helpful suggestions of things you may want to bring to swim meets:

- -Pack healthy snacks and drinks for your child to have (Please note that we request items to be nut-free due to a severe nut allergy)
- -Pack your child 2 towels.
- -Bring a chair for yourself just in case there's not enough seating.
- -Pen, Highlighter, and Sharpie.
- -Money to purchase programs and snacks from concession stand.

Description of Jobs:

Timers:

This is not as intimidating as it sounds! Your job is time the races with stopwatches and record the times on the timing sheet. You are the back up to the touchpad. Two timers per lane are required. A timer's meeting will be held prior to the start time. Please note the meet cannot start until all timers are present.

- ~Please note that when our team attends meets that are not hosted by us we are still required to provide timers. **Sign ups for timing will be available on the team site.**
- ~Timing at USA meets will be assigned to families attending these meets. Please note you will be notified by email if you are required to time.

Back up Timer:

Your job is to start and stop extra stopwatches in case one of the timers at the lanes need a new stopwatch.

Deck Runners:

Don't worry running is not part of this job. The runners collect the timing sheets from the timers and bring them to the computer table. Also post results in hallway for parents to see.

Concession Stand:

We need 2-3 parents to work the concession stand at our team hosted dual meets. With enough parents helping its easy to take a break to watch your child swim!!

Meet Marshal:

The meet marshals keep the stairs and doorways clear. Meet marshals are only needed at Supersplash.

Officials Room Overseer:

The officials room needs to be overseen by a parent throughout the day, this means making coffee, serving food and keeping the room tidy. This is an important job, the officials volunteer there time and deserve to be well taken care of! The room also has a full view of the pool!

Officials:

Officials are required to officiate swim meets. Officials are parent volunteers who have taken the training course to become an official. The Ymca will pay for the training course. Our team is in need of more officials if your interested in becoming an official please contact Coach Dennie.
