

Swim Meet Entry Process



- Members receive an email to declare attendance.
- Log into TeamUnify or Ondeck account to choose the desired meet and declare attending or not attending and the sessions your swimmer can swim.
- Coaches determine events for each swimmer. Questions about events for your swimmer... either leave a remark in the notes box or speak to your child's coach.
- Coach Jeff and Coach Kathy compile meet entries and submit the team registration
- Meet entry fees will be billed on the 1st of the following month.

BPR Dues



- Collected upon registration via TeamUnify
- Automated invoices for installments



 Paid to BP Municipality to cover Coaching Payroll

Seasonal/Tiered Dues Structure

- Tier 1 (2 Seasons)
 - Senior, Platinum, Gold
 - 2-seasons Short Course (Sept to Mar) and Long Course (Apr to Aug) seasons
 - 2 payment options pay full-season at registration OR 3 installments
- Tier 2 (4 Seasons)
 - Silver, Bronze, Gold 2
 - 4-seasons Fall (Sept to Nov), Winter (Dec to Mar), Spring (Apr to May), and Summer (June to July)
 - Full-season cost due upon registration
- There will be no refunds for those who choose not to complete the season.

Multi-Athlete Discount



Families with more than one swimmer will benefit from a discount of their **total dues** based on the number of swimmers. The discount structure is detailed in the table below.

- This discount is automatically applied upon payment for multiple swimmers simultaneously.
- When swimmers are registered individually, discounts must be manually credited after registration is complete.
- Sharks swimmers are not included in the multi-athlete discount.

USA Swimming Registration

T-shirt and Cap Fee

- \$40 fee per swimmer is collected upon registration and covers the cost of team swim caps and a team t-shirt.
- All caps are to be used for meets, please do your best to purchase separate caps for practice use.
- Athletes who register after September 9th will not receive personalized caps.

Meet entry fees

- Fees are charged by the meet host.
- Billed on the 1st of the month following the meet.

USA Swimming



What is the USA Swimming?

- BPR is a member of USA Swimming, our National Governing Body, the same governing body that selects the USA Olympic Swimming Team.
- Allegheny Mountain Swimming (AMS), our Local Swimming Committee (LSC) within USA Swimming, covers western Pennsylvania and governs our operation within USA Swimming.
- All swimmers must register with USA Swimming to be able to practice and compete and for liability and insurance through USA Swimming.

USA Swimming Registration

- New swimmers will be provided a registration link for USA Swimming.
- Returning swimmers will be renewed by BPR for 2024 after October 1. You will be billed on Nov 1.
- Registration provides athlete eligibility through December 31, 2024.
- Premium Membership (Senior, Platinum, Gold, Gold 2, Silver, Bronze) \$90.
- Flex Membership (Sharks) \$30
 - Should you move into the Bronze Group or above during 2024, your registration will be upgraded at a cost of \$60.



BPR CLEARANCES



Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance (Act 151)

Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Record Check (Act 34)

FBI Federal Criminal History Record (Act 114)

Volunteers who have resided in Pennsylvania for ALL of the past 10 years and have never been convicted of a Disqualifying Offense may request a waiver of the FBI Fingerprint Clearance.

*At least one adult associated with your swim account needs to take one of three actions.

- 1. Clearances may be expiring or expired and we need to have updated copies e-mailed to us for verification. You can find links to complete new clearances at https://www.bpsd.org/VolunteerInformation.aspx.
- 2. We may be missing a copy of one of the documents and need to obtain one from you.
- 3. We may need new copies of all three documents.

Why:

- Be more involved in your child's sport
- Enjoy swim meets from the deck instead of the stands (at all venues)
- Earn volunteer hours toward BPR Club requirement
- Help BPR to host meets staffed by BPR officials
- Without a full staff of officials, swimmers times will not count

Benefits: Parents that train to become officials have the opportunity to also receive a refund at the end of the swim year.

- You must have finished all of the trainings and the clinic by the start of the short course season to receive the end of year refund
- You must work both the short course and long course seasons to be eligible to receive the end of year refund.







