

PARENT - CODE OF CONDUCT

As a parent/guardian of a swimmer and member of Baldwin Whitehall Aquatics (BWA), I will abide by the following rules:

- 1. I will encourage my child to swim because I realize participation is voluntary.
- 2. I will not force my swimmer to participate in meets and/or events at any time.
- 3. I will make every effort to have my swimmer on pool deck in time for practices, meets or any other events.
- 4. It is my responsibility to notify the coaches of any injury or illness prior practices, meets or any other events.
- 5. I will not interrupt the coaches while coaching unless asked to do so or in an emergency.
- 6. I understand that I am not permitted on the pool deck during practices, meets or other events. If I have an issue that needs addressed I am to contact the coach via email.
- 7. I will ensure that my swimmer is picked up by an adult on time at the end of the session.
- 8. I understand that the officials who judge meets are volunteers and have the best interest of all swimmers in mind. If I have a question pertaining to a call/decision of an official I am to direct it to BWA coaching staff.
- 9. I will at all times demonstrate good sportsmanship.
