Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent/legal guardian of a NAC registered swimmer and member of Norwin Aqua Club, I agree with the following statements.

- 1. I will be a positive role model for my child by demonstrating good sportsmanship and by showing respect and courtesy to other swimmers, parents, officials and the coaches at meets and practices. Any behavior that brings discredit or disruption to our swimmers and our organization will not be tolerated and is unacceptable.
- 2. I will not coach or instruct the team or any swimmer at a practice or meets (from the stands or any other area) or interfere with coaches on the pool deck.
- 3. I understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language or gestures directed toward the coaches, officials, other parents, and/or any participating swimmer will not be permitted or tolerated.
- 4. I will be involved with NAC by supporting the swimmers, coaches and other parents with positive communication and actions.
- 5. I will ensure that my child treats other swimmers, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with respect.
- 6. I understand that if a problem or concern is identified, I will calmly seek solutions at a proper time and location, refraining from confrontations in front of any NAC swimmer.
- 7. I understand that failure to comply with the Code of Conduct as set forth may result in disciplinary action as determined by the NAC Board of Directors and/or USA Swimming Board of Review. I understand that disciplinary action can include but is not limited to immediate dismissal from any NAC practice/meet/activity or suspension for a longer period of time given the nature of the incident(s). Suspensions or termination of membership will be determined by the NAC Board.
