ADDEDNDUM to Jets Code of Conduct – Athlete

Dear Jets Parents and Families,

We wanted to alert you to a few changes in our rules and regulations at both St. Bernards and the City Pool. We also have an addendum to the Jets Code of Conduct- Athlete we would like you to share with your swimmer to ensure a fun environment for all swimmers and safety for all.

St. Bernards:

- Please ensure that your young swimmers in groups silver 2, silver 1, green 2 and green 1 are escorted into the pool area and they do not loiter in the locker room/bathroom area without supervision.
- Swimmers 6 years and under need to have a parent in the waiting area if needed during practice for assistance to the restroom.
- We ask that all swimmers to be informed to use the restroom prior to swim practice.
- The hot tub in the pool is off limits to all swimmers who do not have a St. Bernards membership.
- No swimmers need to be loitering in the locker room/bathroom or weight room areas.
- No swimmers should be entering the pool area through the staff hallway unsupervised.
- Parents who would like to wait on their swimmers will need to wait in the waiting area located by the front desk alongside the staircase.
- Per St. Bernard's rules, opposite sex children over the age of 2 must use the family restroom/locker room.

City Pool:

- No swimmers are to be in the Storage room or Lifeguard office without supervision.
- No swimmers are allowed to enter the new renovated Center while in wet suits or clothing including the basketball and turf areas.

(Addendum to the Jets Code of Conduct – Athlete)

- Swimmers will need to enter the pool feet first at the start of each practice, no diving will be allowed unless instructed by a Jets Coach.
- No kicking, hitting, pulling on limbs, or splashing excessively with teammates or Coaches.
- No screaming or talking back to Coaches.

• Swimmers MUST listen for instruction from coaches, NOT sit on the wall talking excessively to other swimmers.

Disciplinary Action

If the Athlete Code of Conduct is violated the following actions will take place:

- 1. A warning will be issued to the swimmer.
- 2. A time out on deck will be issued to the swimmer.
- 3. Suspension from the rest of practice followed by a meeting with the parents
- 4. Continued violations may result in further suspension from practices up to, and including, dismissal from the team.

This Code of Conduct is also reviewed as part of a swimmer's regular assessment.

**We encourage an overall good attitude and good listening skills with teammates and coaches during practice to ensure a safe and fun swim experience. **

I understand that if I violate this code of conduct, I will be subject to disciplinary action determined by my coaches and the swim club's board of directors.
