The same weekend many of our Senior swimmers were in Portland, Oregon competing with some of the best swimmers from across the West at the Sectional Championship. Also on that same busy weekend a contingent of Summer and Trident Team swimmers racing in the Grand Canyon State Games. Swim Neptune had an amazing performance at the Age Group State Championship, finishing 2nd place overall with a many State Champions, both individually and in relays. There were many new entries to the team Top 10 Times list which will be updated in August.

There is one more meet to go, the USA Swimming Junior National Championship in Irvine, CA where Jason Sugihara and Langston Lindsey will represent Swim Neptune competing against the best 18&Under swimmers in the US. Great job to all on a spectacular summer season.

## COMPETITIVE TEAM REQUIREMENTS!

The second half [2/1 - 7/31/2025] of any unworked Volunteer hours and unearned Fundraising will be billed at the end of July to be paid on August 1. If you have any questions, contact helenz@swimneptune.com. The swim season runs from August - July. The Fundraising commitment is \$180 per family and the Volunteer hour commitment is 24 per family [White/Trident group swimmers have 16 hours]. It is the responsibility of the USA registered families to keep track of hours earned and posted to your account online. To view hours click "My Account", "Account Info", "Service Hour" tab. Trident families that are NOT USA Swimming members do not have these requirements. Dive Neptune members do not have these requirements.

## Swim Neptune Weather Policy:

As you know the weather in Arizona is extremely unpredictable and fast moving. We will swim in the rain, but if there is lightning involved we must pull everyone from the water and clear the deck for safety reasons.

We monitor lightning carefully and closely to keep all our swimmers safe. The coaches on deck and the manager of the facility will cancel practice and close the pool if there is lightning and this can happen fast! If possible, coaches may send an email about a closure, but they are not sent until it is almost practice time, in case the weather clears. As quickly as a storm comes, it can clear and be back to sunny weather.

We cannot solve the problem of driving to practice then having it cancelled. We could be swimming one minute and have the pool closed the next minute. If you email or text and ask if there will be practice at a certain location at a certain time we will not be able to tell you with certainty. We also understand if you decide not to come to practice because of weather concerns. Many drive a long way and we understand if you don't want to risk the drive on the chance practice will be cancelled. We won't hold it against you!

We realize this is frustrating for everyone, but the safety of our swimmers and coaches is the highest priority.
