Whether you're just learning how to streamline or you're chasing championship cuts, resilience is essential at every stage of a swimmer's journey.

#### For Our Trident Level Swimmers:

Learning to swim isn't always smooth. It takes patience to kick, breathe, and move all at once! Especially with four different stroke to learn. Mistakes and frustration are part of the process. Resilience means showing up again after a tough practice or pushing through the fear of trying something new.

#### For Our Age Group Swimmers:

As your skills grow, so do your goals. You may face plateaus or feel stuck trying to drop time. Resilience here means trusting the process, staying consistent, and believing that growth comes with time and effort, even when progress might feel slow.

### For Our Senior Swimmers:

At the elite level, setbacks can be even more intense. This can be missed cuts, close finishes, or tough races. Resilience is what helps you refocus, reframe failure as feedback, and return to the pool more motivated than ever. Resilient swimmers don't avoid struggle—they grow from it. #### **TEAM RENEWAL REMINDER!**

Swim Neptune team wide annual renewal started August 2 at http://www.SwimNeptune.com! Your swimmer's status was set to "Waiting for Approval" until Registration Renewal is completed. Everyone continuing on the team must renew by the end of August in order to continue swimming in September. Your swimmer will not be Active in September unless you complete the renewal registration online. Swimmers must be renewed in order to sign up for swim meets! #### **SWIM NEPTUNE DUES BILLING INFORMATION**

Swim Neptune reviews the fee structure each year to determine if operational costs and revenue are in reasonable balance. The cumulative effect of inflation over the past few years and significant increases in pool costs has seriously impacted all expense categories for the team. Dues billing has been reviewed for each practice group and each practice location to take into consideration its unique situation. Factors include time in water, costs associated with each location and time since last significant dues increase. Dues increases for returning swimmers will take effect on September 1. To check your dues rate, click on Dues Schedule on the top menu bar of your Account screen. There has been no change in the fundraising or volunteer requirements.

# **ALCATRAZ/GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE SWIMS**

Escape Your Limitations! The Neptune Swimming Foundation sponsors two legendary back-to-back open water swims scheduled for April 18/19, 2026. Alcatraz is a 1.4 mile swim from Alcatraz Island to San Francisco's Aquatic Park. Golden Gate is a 1.2 mile crossing under the Golden Gate Bridge. This is the 19th year we will take a group of swimmers age 98Up on this incredible aquatic adventure. Join us at Bartlett Lake's Rattlesnake Cove starting at 10AM on Saturday October 4th. We will kick things off with an information meeting and follow that immediately with a swim in the Cove. This is the only non-wetsuit swim.

# **COMPETITIVE TEAM REQUIREMENTS**

The first half [8/1-1/31] of any unworked Volunteer hours and/or Fundraising not completed will be billed at the end of January to be paid on February 1st. If you have questions or requests, please contact helenz@swimneptune. com. The swim season runs from August - July. The Fundraising commitment is \$180 per family and the Volunteer hour commitment is 24 per family (White group families have 16 hours). It is the responsibility of all USA registered families to keep track of hours earned and posted to your account online. To view hours click "My Account", "Account Info", "Service Hour" tab. Trident families that are NOT USA Swimming members do not have these requirements. Dive Neptune members **do not** have these requirements.

# **SWIM NEPTUNE WEATHER POLICY**

The weather in Arizona is extremely unpredictable and fast moving. We will swim in the rain, but if there is lightning involved we must pull everyone from the water and clear the deck for safety reasons.

We monitor lightning carefully and closely to keep all our swimmers safe. The coaches on deck and the manager of the facility will cancel practice and close the pool if there is lightning and this can happen fast! If possible, coaches may send an email about a closure, but they are not sent until it is almost practice time, in case the weather clears. As quickly as a storm comes, it can clear and be back to sunny weather.

We cannot solve the problem of driving to practice then having it cancelled. We could be swimming one minute and have the pool closed the next minute. If you email or text and ask if there will be practice at a certain location at a certain time we will not be able to tell you with certainty. We also understand if you decide not to come to practice because of weather concerns. Many drive a long way and we understand if you don't want to risk the drive on the chance practice will be cancelled. We won't hold it against you!

We realize this is frustrating for everyone, but the safety of our swimmers and coaches is the highest priority.
