

VIP (Very Important Parent) Volunteer Program

Families are asked to participate in our volunteer program and the following hours are the minimum to complete the following hours per cycle per family:

Bronze - 5 hrs per cycle

Silver - 10 hrs per cycle

Gold - 10 hrs per cycle

*During the high school swim season (Aug. - Oct.) hours volunteered at HS meets count towards NLSC Matsu volunteer hours.

Cycles

Cycle 1 - Aug 1st - Dec 31st

Cycle 2 - Jan 1st - Jul 31st

Hours do not carry over. NLSC Matsu families will be subject to an Hours Requirement Fee (HRF) of \$20 per hour per cycle for hours not fulfilled.

Recording of service hours all families are required to sign up for event jobs via Team Unify. Hours will be added to your account within one week of the event. You are responsible for checking your hours or notifying the Volunteer Coordinator for changes or additions. You can contact Volunteer Coordinator Christen Moffat moffatmama@gmail.com
