Kenna put on a show in South Gate last weekend, bagging five personal best times and becoming the first Beach 1 athlete to qualify for a SoCal Swimming championship meet this season, with a HUGE swim the 100 Breast. Her time of 1:37.78 in her first ever SCY 100 Breast qualified her for this weekend's Winter Age Group Championships in San Clemente by just 12 hundredths of a second! She scored two podium finishes in South Gate, in the 100 Breast (2nd place) and the 50 Breast (3rd place) and dropped a total of 15.19 seconds across 5 races. This young lady loves to race and it showed in a big way. Congratulations, Kenna!
