

Volunteer Policies

Our success is only possible with the dedicated efforts of all Rosemead Rapids families. Parental support and involvement is essential to the success of our team.

All families are required to fulfill 10 volunteer hours per year. Volunteer hours can be fulfilled in several ways: meet timing, meet timing coordinator, event coordinator, event volunteer, and event donations.

There will be a penalty charge of \$15 for every volunteer hour not fulfilled by the end of the season or at the time of account suspension. The end date of the season will be the last day of competition for the SCS Summer Junior Olympics.

Meet Timing

During swim meets, timing is a responsibility of all teams in attendance. Timing is a mandatory team obligation for all families with swimmer(s) participating at a swim meet except for the meet timing coordinator. A web-based sign-up sheet will be posted and families will be notified prior to each meet. Sign-up will be closed the night prior to the first day of competition. Families that do not sign up for a volunteer spot will have a chance to sign up at the meet. All open spots must be filled. If the responsible party is unable to fulfill that timing position for any reason, it is his/her responsibility to find a replacement.

For those families who have older swimmers that drive themselves to meets, you are still responsible for away meet timing. It is your responsibility to fulfill your timing obligation either by your swimmer or another family member.

Parents of swimmers in the long distance events (400 IM, 400/500 Freestyle, 800/1000 Freestyle or 1500/1650 Freestyle) are responsible for timing 3 heats of those events in addition to your regular meet timing obligation.

All families must check in with the Timing Coordinator before the start of the meet.

Families must volunteer to time regardless of fulfillment of volunteer hours.
