Confusion – Part 1: STAR Sr Q Qualifier

Anyone who isn't confused here doesn't really understand what's going on. (Anonymous)

On Jan 18-19 our team attended 3 different swim meets. and two of them were at the same location.

- (1) SCS Senior Q Qualifier at STAR– (was held in the morning);
- (2) BR SCY at STAR (was held in the afternoon)
- (3) Road to Omaha Senior Meet

In over 5 years I've never seen 2 totally different meets on the same day at the same location. Then, adding to the confusion, last minute changes to the qualifying standards for the Senior Q Challenge meet had our heads spinning. But, in order to figure out what was going on, here's some background for the Q meets.

BACKGROUND FOR THE Q MEETS

Within Southern California Swimming (SCS) there are 6 Geo(graphic)-Committees: Coastal, Desert, Eastern, Metro, Orange, and Pacific. We are one of 33 teams in the Eastern Geo-Committee. SCS sponsors a senior competition between the Geo-Committees. The idea was for each Geo-Committee to bring their best senior team to compete against each other.

Each Geo-Committee was to hold a Q Qualifier meet to determine who would represent their Geo-Committee. The top 6 times in each event would qualify for their Geo-Committee team AND, ONLY swimmers attending the Q Qualifier would be eligible for the team. Since this is a Senior meet there are no age groups and no age limits. All swimmers who met the qualifying standards could compete -13's were competing against 20's and 30's.

Except for a few swimmers attending the Road to Omaha meet, we sent our best Titanium and Platinum swimmers to this meet.

At the coaches meeting, 10 minutes before the start of the meet, the coaches were informed the rules had changed for how swimmers and teams could qualify for the SCS Sr Q Challenge. The new rules were:

- (1) Everyone who swam any event at the Q Qualifier meet would qualify to swim at the SCS Sr Q Challenge. Not only that, they could swim ANY 6 events ... there was no qualifying time standard.
- (2) Anyone who swam at the Road to Omaha meet could qualify to swim at the SCS Sr Q Challenge but ONLY their Road events plus bonus.
- (3) Anyone who met the Road to Omaha time standard (equivalent to Sectional Bonus times) could swim those events at the SCS Sr Q Challenge

OK, confusion was rampant. What did that mean for the top 6 times? How does the Geo-Committee enter swimmers? As it turned out, the SCS Sr Q Challenge was no longer a competition between Geo-Committees ... it was just another (LCM) senior swim meet.

What Happened

Looking at what happened to this meet gives a very good insight to the challenges of holding swim meets. Swim meets are expensive to run. The pool must be rented for 2-3 days, admin and officials need to be paid (and fed), awards need to be purchased, etc. In addition, meets are one of the few ways teams have to generate income. If a meet doesn't have a good turnout the team will lose money.

As the entries came in for the Orange, Metro, and Pacific Geo-Committees there were not enough swimmers entered to make it financially feasible to hold meets at 3 different locations. So, at the last minute, all three Geo-Committee meets were combined into one qualifying meet.

Also, for our Eastern Geo-Committee there was not enough swimmers to cover all the costs for STAR. So, an afternoon meet was added to the schedule at the last minute. And that is how the afternoon STAR BR SCY meet was born.
