The November FAC meet challenged our swimmers and there were a lot of great swims as well as some struggles and learning experiences. This happened to a few of our swimmers. They came away from the meet with a lot of learning opportunities (DQs). Did they give up? Did they surrender? No, our coaches say they come to practice with a positive attitude and continue to put in the hard work. Many of these swimmers are signed up for the CCAQ meet. This is strength! They are our future and are the definition of Mental Toughness.

Really testing our Mental Toughness has been access to training facilities. With our primary pool shut down for repairs we've had to look to other facilities. Some were struggles but our team persevered, and the results of this meet are the proof that as a TEAM we have become stronger. The award for Mental Toughness goes to our parents, our coaches, our swimmers. We are a TEAM!

We had 50 swimmers competing in 267 events, picking up 43 New C Times, 22 New B Times, 5 New BB Times, 6 New A Times, 4 New AA Times, 1 New AAA Time, 1 New AAAA Time. They earned 125 awards for a total of 2753 points. 26 of the swims earned spots in the TOP 10.

## AMAZING SWIMS

Jonathan Ko, Platinum, what can we say. Jonathan continues to dominate the meet picking up another Quad A (AAAA) time for his 50 Breast. (We think Jonathan is a Breaststroker). He also picked up another AAA Time and 2 more AA Times. Another 4 TEAM RECORDS, 71 TT Place and $22^{\text {nd }}$ place finishes for 176 TOTAL POINTS! 6 Top 10 Swims. Fabulous!

Dominic Valdriz, Gold, continues to impress with his consistent amazing swims. He picked up another A Time and another AA Time, plus qualified an event for JAG and SumAG championships. Dominic finished with $31^{\text {st }}$ place, 12 nd place, 2 3rd place, and a 4th place for 125 Total Points. 6 swims were Top 10 Swims, 1 was a New Top 10. Awesome!

Charlotte Ngan, Gold, earned a New AA Time and qualified her event for the fastest Age Group championships - SCS AG Elite Championship and Far Westerns. She finished with 2 2nd places, $33^{\text {rd }}$ places, $24^{\text {th }}$ places, and a $5^{\text {th }}$ place for 140 Total Points. 3 of her swims were Top 10. One was a New Top 10. Well done!
