# Gorilla Wrestling .... CCAQ Meet Recap

The December 2023 CCAQ A/BB/B/C WAG Last Ditch swim meet was a lot like Gorilla Wrestling. At times it seemed a toss-up who would tire first ... the Gorilla (meet timeline) or our coaches and parents who had 10 and under and 13 and over swimmers! For them each day was a 12 hour day. It was even longer for the Officials, Admin, and meet host! Many events had 80 - 107 swimmers entered. Thank goodness the meet ran 12 lanes, or we'd still be there.

I am proud to say our 44 swimmers and parents did not quit. They out lasted the Gorilla ... success was theirs! For a rundown of what happened and why the meet ran so long see the Wrapup.

This was an 'everybody can swim' meet. *Dorothy Liu* earned some new times for her first ever swim meet. We know she has just begun to wrestle the gorilla.

We had 44 swimmers competing in events with 80-107 entries. Platinum was represented by 4 swimmers (40%); Gold was represented by 11 swimmers (65%); Silver was represented by 6 swimmers (43%); Bronze Elite was represented by 5 swimmers (22%), Bronze was represented by 17 swimmers (21%); High School Prep was represented by 1 swimmer (13%).

Our swimmers netted 33 New C times, 11 new B times, 3 new BB times, 4 new A times, 2 new AA times, 2 new JAG times, and 2 new SumAG times.

Competition was fierce with 1,027 swimmers competing, many events had 80-107 entries. 20 of our swimmers picked up 75 awards (places 1-6). Now that is success!

### **OUTSTANDING SWIMS**

**Dominic Valdriz,** Gold, had a great meet. He swam to 3 New A times, 1 new AA time, a new JAG qualifying time, and a new SumAG qualifying time. His 50 Back was a NEW TEAM RECORD! **Dominic** placed 7 events (2 1st place, 2 2nd place, 2 3rd place, and 1 4th place), earning 123 points. 6 of his swims were in the TOP 10 TIMES. **Dominic** dominated the Gorilla!

### ON THE WATCH LIST

Last September, *Aiden Lee*, Platinum, competed in his very first swim meet ever. All his events were First Time B and BB times. Since then, *Aiden* has competed in every meet he qualified for and continues to impress. At this meet *Aiden* qualified 2 New WAG events, a New JAG event, and a New SumAG event besides adding another A time and BB time to his impressive inventory. *Aiden* picked up a 1<sup>st</sup> place, a 2<sup>nd</sup> place, a 3rd place, and 2 4<sup>th</sup> place awards, earning 98 points and had 2 NEW TOP 10 swims. *Aiden* has been on the watch list for awhile now. We cannot wait to see what he does next!

## **WRAP UP**

The will to win, the desire to succeed, the urge to reach your full potential...these are the keys that will unlock the door to personal excellence. (Confucius)

Our athletes will to win, desire to succeed, and the urge to reach their full potential was pitted against the gorilla. It's easy to tell our kids don't quit until the gorilla is tired and, even then, they don't quit. We are very proud of our swimmers and their parents for committing to unlock the door to personal excellence in a very challenging meet.

So, what happened? Why so many swimmers all of a sudden?

Prior to the COVID-19 pandemic there were around 26,000 swimmers in Southern California Swimming (SCS). To accommodate that many competitors for 'everybody can swim' meets our Eastern Committee used dual pools (2 different pools for a meet). After the pandemic ended, SCS had about 16,000 registered swimmers. That's a decrease of about 40%. Also, some teams did not recover, and many facilities were slow to return while other pools were no longer available. (And facility costs went up significantly.)

Our Eastern Committee plans meets a calendar year in advance. Meets for 2022 were planned for the normal dual meets but attendance was so low that the dual facility meets had to be combined into one facility. When planning mid 2022 for 2023 no dual facility meets were planned. The good news is that the CCAQ meet showed swimming registration and meet attendance is recovering. The bad news is that we only had one facility planned. According to Julie, the meet Admin, "This was a total surprise, we did not see this coming".

The challenging news is that we have another 'everybody can swim' meet in January. They are working on this. It will be interesting. There are no other 'everybody can swim' meets planned for 2024 so our beginner and 'C' level swimmers need to take advantage of every beginner meet in order to get those minimum B times!
