DEFINITIONS:

Varsity:

Elite level teams wishing to participate in the Varsity division. Will compete in Prelims session on Friday, the Top 27 swimmers advance to the Finals session held on Saturday starting at 3:00 pm. Teams entered in this division will earn points towards Varsity scoring. Awards will be earned in this division (top 10 individual and 3 relays). There are entry standards for all events in this portion of the meet (except relays, and 50 and 100 FR). Times earned here can be used for CIF qualification purposes.

JV/OPEN:

The OPEN portion is relatively new and is being formalized this year.

This meet is for Junior varsity and other varsity teams that do not feel they would be as competitive in the elite division. This is a Timed Finals session (one swim only per event). There is no chance to qualify for the Saturday Finals session from this session. Awards will be earned in this division (top 3 individual and 1st relay). Times swum in this session can be used for CIF qualification purposes.

Example: in the past we have seen teams from CIF D4 take advantage of this division. There are NO entry standards in this portion of the meet.

ENTRIES:

All swimming entries are to be done via www.swimmeetmaker.com all entries should be completed online and before 11:45 pm on Tuesday March 8th. No late entries will be accepted!

USS Swimmers: it is the coaches responsibility to enter each swimmers **USS #** in swimmeetmaker at the time of entry. The meet staff will NOT do this for you.

All diving entries are to be done via www.divemeets.com - Please also remember to enter your divers on your official Swimmeetmaker.com website as well. All entries should be completed online and before 11:45 pm on Tuesday April 8th. No late entries will be accepted!

To ensure entry accuracy, please assign only one coach to be "responsible" for all team entries. ENTRY LIMITS:

Normal CIF rules apply to entry limits per swimmer: total of 4 events, max 2 individual

Varsity Coaches may enter a max. Of 6 entrants per event

JV/Open Coaches may enter a max. Of 6 entrants per event...except

in the JV. 50 and JV/OPEN 100 free where you may enter 9 swimmers.

Relays:

JV/Open Will be swum in the morning timed finals session

Varsity Will be swum in the finals session only (on Saturday afternoon)

RELAYS ENTRY LIMITS:

1 relay team per school per event

<u>Teams traveling more than 100 miles</u> to the event may enter a non-scoring "B" relay by entering those teams on the swimmeetmaker.com site. If not able to complete that process, please notify swimmeetmaker.com administrator by clicking on the "contact us" button on the site.

READ THIS!



Coaches: if you are entering an athlete in the 500 free, please be <u>certain</u> they intend to swim the event. We do not want scratches in this event. If you scratch a swimmer after the event becomes final, it will be highly frowned upon.

- there will be a maximum of **8** heats allowed in varsity boys, and **8** heats in varsity girls (**5** in prelims, 3 finals ea.)
- The fastest <u>3</u> heats will be swum in the FINALS session. The slowest 5 heats will be swum in PRELIMS from slowest to fastest). THIS IS A TIMED FINAL EVENT.
- All other heats will be swum in prelims session.
- If your swimmer does not make the "cut off" time (top **72** entered times), you will be able to select a new event for that swimmer prior to the printing of the event program (9:00 am Thursday). **No JV 500 free.**

ENTRY TIMES:

In order to enter an event with an entry time limit, you must have achieved that time. Please no guessing or entering someone in that event not capable of achieving that entry time. See list of events for entry times. There are no entry time limits for JV/Open (Saturday morning).

USS Swimmers:

All results will be sent to So Cal Swimming for entry into their system on the Monday after the conclusion of the meet.

Your swimmer must have been entered into the meet with their USS # attached to their name (in swimmeetmaker.com). THIS MUST BE DONE AT THE TIME OF MEET ENTRY. THE MEET STAFF WILL NO LONGER DO THIS FOR YOU (too many mistakes and too time consuming). This is the team coaches responsibility to get this completed. From what I have been told, The results generally take a few weeks to be confirmed and uploaded into the USS system. Mt. SAC has no input or influence over that system.

SCORING:

The top 27 swimmers will return in each event for varsity finals (to be swum on saturnday) and will socre for their team. The top 27 will score for JV/OPEN. The top 27 will score in diving events.

AWARDS:

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: Varsity Champion in each individual event will receive a special chenille patch

Varsity Place 2-10 individual events will receive a commemorative medal with neck ribbon.

Varsity Relay Champions receive a special chenille patch

Varsity Relays place 2-3 receive a commemorative medal with neck ribbon

JV/Open Individual events place 1-3 receive a commemorative medal with neck ribbon

JV/Open Relays place 1 will receive a commemorative medal with neck ribbon.

TEAM AWARDS: Team 1-3 place in Varsity receives a special team banner

Combined (Boys and Girls) Varsity Champions receives a special banner.

JV/Open division place 1-3 boys and girls receive a team plaque

Your team will not be given their awards if you have not made proper meet entry payments, or made arrangements with event management.

RESULTS:

All results will be posted live on the HyTek MeetMobile App, and on SwimMeetMaker.com (at conclusion of meet). All Diving results will be posted on www.divemeets.com. Results may also be posted on SwimCloud.com (after the conclusion of the meet).

PARKING:

The best options for parking at our new facility will be the **gateway parking structure** (located just west of the pool – there is a walkway from level 3 directly to the pool area), or in the **champions structure** lower level (located just south of the pool area ON BONITA WAY) with the purchase of a parking permit (available in all lots for \$5.00/day). Parking regulations are in effect 24/7. See parking map for details.

All Bus drop-offs and pick-ups will be in the F parking lot (located just north of Temple Ave. and the pool. Buses will drop student athletes off at the far north-east end of that lot (please follow arrows).

Student athletes will then walk through the tunnel (under Temple Ave) then around the gym to the pool area. It is a very short walk.

All buses will be able to remain parked in that area, or leave and return to that spot for pick up.

NO BUS DROP-OFF OR PICK-UP BY THE POOL - MUST BE DONE IN THE F PARKING LOT.

FACILITY:

Two 9 lane competition pools swimming into bulkhead (North course for the GIRLS, and South course for the BOYS – in PRELIMS). Omega electronic timing system and 2 full color *Multimedia LED®* scoreboards for the swimming competition and 1 full color board for the diving pool. 13 x 25 yd warm-up lanes will be available throughout meet in the diving pool (prelims day) and 17 x 25 yd warm up lanes will be available for finals. Seating for 2500 on stadium seating above deck and covered. Coaches seating available on the east side of the competition area above the deck. Shade/rain coverage will be provided for coaches and spectators throughout the meet. We will block off that area for coaches only, we will provide tables for the rows closest to the rail. Drink Rails/Work surfaces will also be available for coaches overlooking both competition courses.

Coaches will be allowed on deck, but no coaches seating will be allowed on deck.

Thank you for your cooperation with this. We think you will find more than acceptable.

CANOPIES:

All team canopies should be placed on grass areas in or around the facility (not blocking walkways). Teams are welcome to sit inside in the bleacher area without canopies.

ADMISSION:

Admission is FREE to all spectators.

PROGRAMS:

Official programs will be available at the meet for coaches in their coaching packets. Meet information will be available on the following sites: Hy-Tek meetmobile app,

VENDOR:

There will be a vendor on site for the meet that will sell official event merchandise as well as to take care of your team and individual swim wear needs. There will be various other vendors on site as well.

COACHES HOSPITALITY:

Pinpoint industries® will be on site to provide coaches hospitality throughout the meet in our VIP lounge located on the 2nd level where the bridge connects to the gym on the north-east corner of the pool 2nd level. Customer service is their specialty, and I am sure you will feel well taken care of at the meet.

CONCESSIONS:

A concession stand will be available throughout the meet with hot and cold food as well as some healthy choices for snacks. The concession stand is located on the second level, gym side of the pool.

COACHES, PLEASE REMEMBER:

The quality of this meet depends upon your accuracy in the entry process. Please make sure you pay very close attention to the times you are entering and to the entry time standards and limits (see above).

If you know one of your varsity swimmers will not be able to return for the Finals session, please notify the event manager prior to the conclusion of the Friday Prelims session (or enter that swimmer as an "exhibition" swimmer in the entry process. They will be seeded normally, just not advanced into the finals session). That way we can post accurate results and finals lists to the website.

We will be swimming and scoring an "A", "B" and "C" finals on Saturday for Varsity, that means the top 27 swimmers in each event will return and score for your team. We will also score the top 27 in each event for the JV/Open timed finals session on Saturday morning.

HOW THE EVENT WILL BE RUN:

- 11 Dives on 1M, 3M, or combination of boards
- We will conduct separate events
 - o Open warm up (boys and girls) may warm up between 8:00 am 9:00 am
 - o GIRLS will start at 10:00 AM (warm up open at 8:00 AM)
 - BOYS will start at 3:00 pm or 1 hour after the conclusion of the GIRLS competition. (warm up immediately following the conclusion of the GIRLS event or apprx 2:00 pm. BOYS may also warm up from 8:00 am -9:00 am during open warm up time.
- We will follow <u>Rule 9, Section 4, Art. 1 on p. 79</u> of the NFHS SWIMMING & DIVING RULE BOOK
- Each school may enter a MAX OF 6 DIVERS (which is consistent with our swimming entry limits)
- We will follow CIF RULES FOR PARTICIPANT ATTENDANCE: an athlete must be accompanied by a coach or certificated district employee or certified adult (as determined by the school private schools)

PARKING:

The best options for parking at our new facility will be the **GATEWAY PARKING STRUCTURE** (located just west of the pool, there is a bridge from the 3rd floor across Bonita Way to the pool area), or in the **CHAMPIONS STRUCTURE** LOWER LEVEL (located just south of the pool area ON BONITA WAY) **WITH THE PURCHASE OF A PARKING PERMIT** (**AVAILABLE IN ALL LOTS FOR \$5.00/DAY**). Parking regulations are in effect 24/7. <u>SEE PARKING MAP</u> for details. Buses may drop off near the pool (at the turn around) and then park in the F Parking lot located just north of the pool on the north side of Temple Ave.
