MIXED-GENDER:	Saturday and Sunday. Swimmers entered with NT (no time) will be seeded last. Friday's distance events will be seeded fastest to slowest. An exemption from the requirement to swim events in gender separated events due to limited time, developmental opportunities or facility requirements and/or due to a missed swim, where on an exception basis, a referee agrees to have the swimmer swim with a heat of an opposite gender event. In spite of these exemptions, any swimmer who achieves a record time at a competition that recognizes records at any level (regional, provincial, national etc, whether age group or open) will not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised the referee prior to the start of the session that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee insures that the swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat. In the event that mixed gender swims are permitted, the results must still be posted separately by gender of swimmers.

They are not eligible for scoring or awards. Deck entries will be accepted for empty lanes only (no new heats will be created).

		Eliminations and Cash Awards will be as follows: Round 1: 2 Eliminated – 6th = \$10, 5th = \$15 Round 2: 1 Eliminated – 4th = \$20 Round 3: 1 Eliminated – 3rd = \$25 Round 4: Winner receives \$50, 2nd - \$30 A cheque will be mailed out to each Club for the total amount of winnings earned. Clubs are responsible for allocating the money to their swimmers.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Please note – coaches may NOT submit entries for the Eliminator events 101-104 as they are reserved for the top 6 finishers in the 200 IM.

Meet Management reserves right to cancel relays as necessary and limit entries if events are oversubscribed to stay within the 4.5h session limit.
