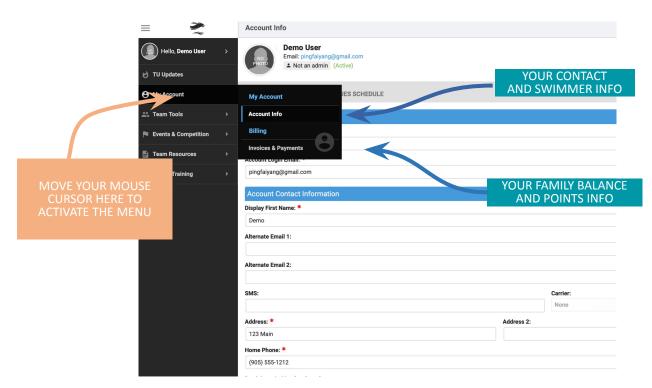

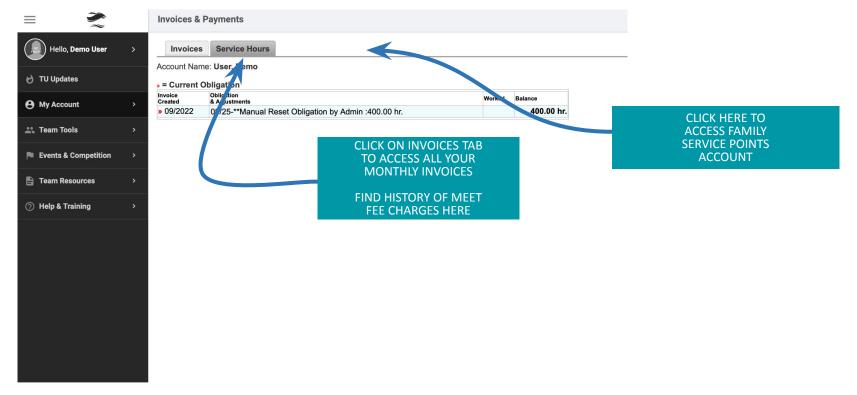
- You should already have an account on the Mallards web site

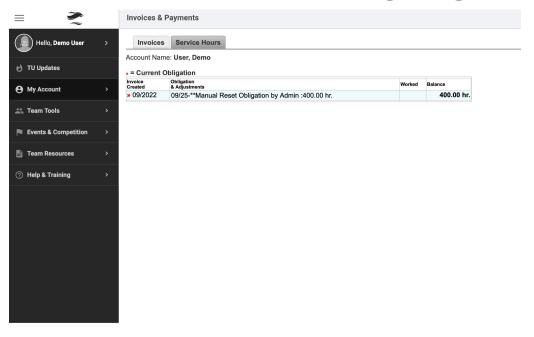
Checking Account Balance and Commitment Points AFTER you have logged in...

Policies and Conduct

Mallards Parents are expected to:

- **Respect other Parents, Swimmers, Volunteers**
- Respect the rules of Swimming and Swim Officials
- Be positive role models for their Swimmers on and off-deck
- Act as ambassadors for Mallards Swim Team

Parents Code of Conduct

- 1. Practice teamwork with all parents, swimmers and coaches by supporting the values of Honesty, Caring, Respect and Responsibility.
- 2. I will not coach or instruct the team or any swimmer at a practice or meets (from the stands or any other areas) that interfere with coaches on the pool deck.
- 3. Demonstrate good sportsmanship by conducting myself in a manner that earns the respect of my child, other swimmers, parents, officials and the coaches at meets and practices.
- 4. Maintain self –control at all times. Know my role.

 Swimmers-Swim; Coaches-Coach; Officials-Officiate; Parents-Parent
- 5. I understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language or gestures directed toward the coaches, officials and /or any participating swimmer will not be permitted or tolerated, and I may be asked to leave the program.
- 6. Enjoy involvement with the Mallards Swimming programs by supporting the swimmers, coaches and other parents with positive communications and actions.
- 7. During competitions, questions or concerns regarding decisions made by meet officials are directed to our coaching staff. Parents address officials via the coaching staff only.

Athlete Code of Conduct

- ~ Obey the provincial law, the federal law, or the law of the country you are visiting.
- ~ No drinking alcohol, no carrying alcoholic beverages, no smoking or chewing tobacco, no carrying or using any social or non-prescription drugs.
- ~ Behave morally, dress respectably, and use only acceptable language.
- ~ Act in a manner that brings credit to your family, your team and yourself.
- ~ Show respect for and co-operate with meet management, pool management, team staff, and all fellow competitors.
- ~ Follow all team, camp, meet and facility rules

The code is in effect from the time of departure until returning home. Any athletes breaking the code will be faced the possibility of being removed from the event and sent home at their expense, pending future review by the disciplinary committee.

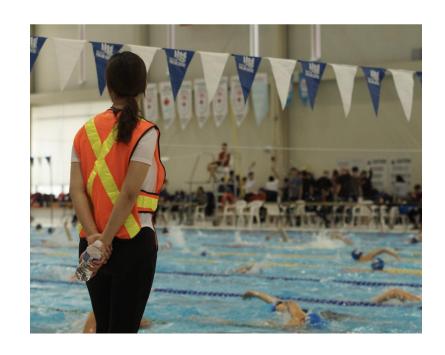

To support and encourage parents participation, Mallards implemented a Family Commitment points system. Parents prepay a commitment fee as a deposit and can earn it back by receiving points throughout the season.

HOW DO I EARN POINTS?

- Volunteer at our club hosted swim meets
- Take a swim officiating clinic (max 15 points awarded for 1 clinic per family per year)
- Work outside meets (15pts/session, max 45pts/year)
- Points vary according to position worked. (It is much easier if multiple family members/friends work as that increases your points per session/meet. Points are tabulated at the end of the year.



WHAT DO I GET FOR VOLUNTEERING / MAKING MY ALLOTTED POINTS?

WHAT IF I MAKE MORE POINTS?

If you earn more points, you will receive a monetary CREDIT at the end of the year to be used for the following swim season (up to \$200 maximum per season)

WHAT IF I MAKE LESS POINTS or DO NOT FULFILL COMMITMENTS?

If you earn less than 85% of your points, you will not receive a refund of your commitment payment. If you earn >85% of your points, you will get a percentage of your \$1,200 back.



▲ A little incentive to get you started:

Volunteer 2 times to earn \$100 refund of your commitment fee

- Prepare a dish at home and bring to the pool for officials' meals
- Sout of raw materials will be reimbursed
- No time commitment on-site but MUST DELIVER FOOD ON TIME!
- 20 points awarded for each portion

Prior to the meet, a form will be emailed to parents. Those interested in this role can submit the form to indicate session availability and what dish they are comfortable preparing

One main will be chosen for each meal- ex.stew, chili, pasta, rice, noodles, stir-fry

Portion size is approx 6qt pot or 12x10 party tray- can commit to preparing more than one portion

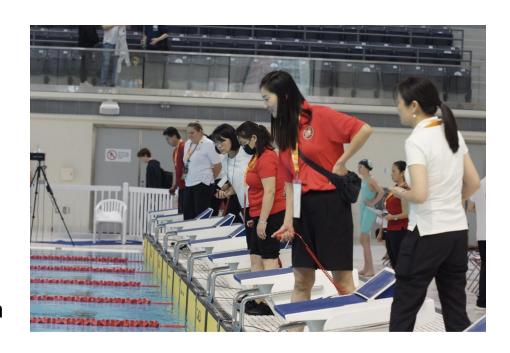

Hurricanes	375pts	360	120	~3-4 sessions (25pt, 30pts or 35pts positions)
Tsunami	350pts	335	110	~3-4 sessions (25pt or 30pts positions)
Lightning/ Tornado	325pts	310	100	~3-4 sessions (25pt or 30pts positions)
Waterspout/ Typhoon	275pts	260	85	~3 sessions (25pts positions)
Avalanche	180pts	165	60	~2-3 sessions (20pts or 25pts positions)

DO I GET POINTS FOR WORKING IN-HOUSE COMPETITIONS OR TIME TRIALS?

There are no points for working at In-House Competitions and Time Trials.

There are no fees charged for swimmers participating in an IHC and TT, while the club incurs an increased facility rental charge for the duration of the event.

Parents of swimmers participating in an IHC/ TT are expected to work or there will be no event.



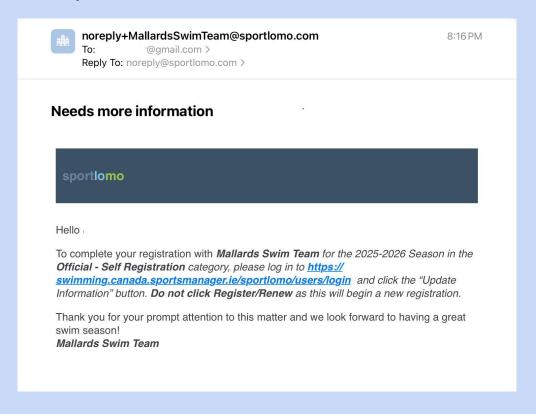

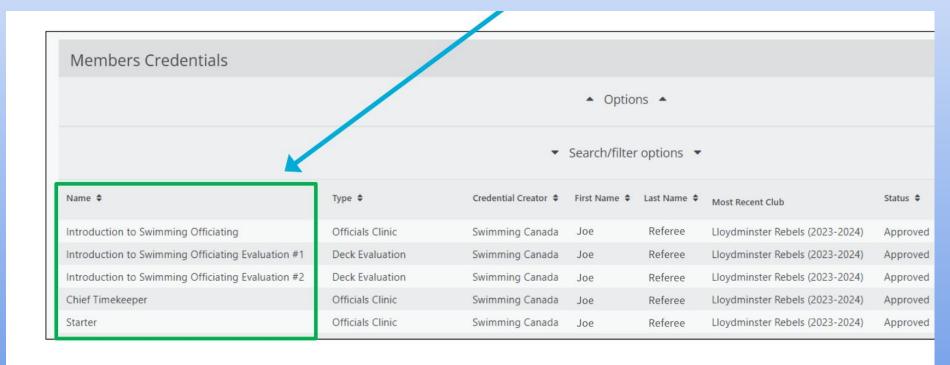

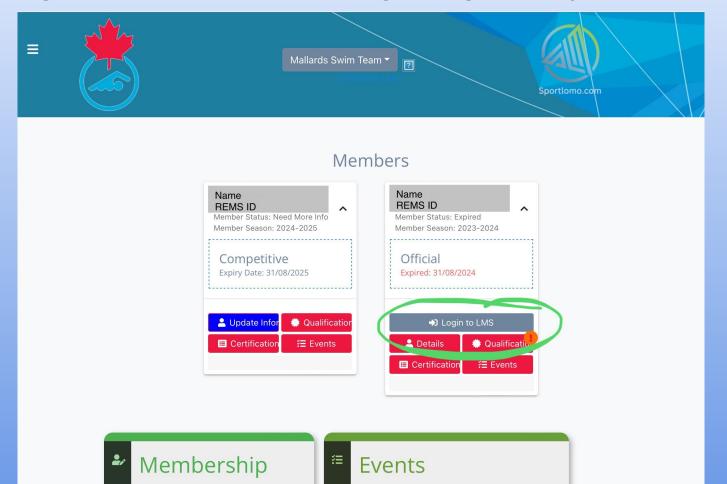

Officials Certification Pathway

LEVEL 1 – RED PIN

A. Complete registration in the Swimming Canada Registration and Events Management

System (REMS).

- B. Complete the Introduction to Swimming Officiating clinic.
- C. Complete the Safety Marshal clinic.

LEVEL 2 – WHITE PIN

- A. Certify in Level I by obtaining **2 successful deck evaluations** in the role of Timekeeper.
- B. Complete the **Inspector of Turns** and **Judge of Stroke** clinics and obtain **2 successful deck evaluations** as an IT and **1** deck evaluation as a JS.
- C. Complete **one other Level II clinic** and obtain **2 successful deck evaluations**: Chief Timekeeper; Administration Desk; Chief Recorder**; Chief Judge Electronics (CJE)**; Meet Manager; Starter.

- 1. Complete both the Chief Recorder and CJE clinics.
- 2. Obtain two deck evaluations:
- o One as a Chief Recorder.
- o One in either role (Chief Recorder or CJE).

^{**}Note: To be certified as a Chief Recorder and Chief Judge Electronics (CJE), an official must:

Officials: Signing up to volunteer for Mallards hosted meets:

- Email will be sent to all parents about a week prior to opening of job sign-up
- Select sessions that you are available to volunteer
- Select only the positions that you are qualified to work
- Indicate the name of the person working the position when signing up
- Sign-up limit per session, per account
- Once the officials assignments are posted, please scan all sessions for your name to ensure that you are assigned in the proper role/session
- Check website for updates of Session Times
- Please be on time for Officials briefings
