POLICY STATEMENT AND OBJECTIVES

Nose Creek Swim Association ("NCSA" or the "Club") would like to acknowledge and reward full-time competitive swimmers with a scholarship for post-secondary education.

1 SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

Up to \$500.00 for each graduating swimmer, to a maximum award of \$2,000.00 combined for all graduating swimmers in any one given one year, subject to final approval by the Board.

2 SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY:

Requirements of the scholarship will be based on the following:

- o registered as a full-time swimmer with NCSA during his/her graduating year,
- Designated as an NCSA swimmer at swim meets,
- o Attending a full-time program at a post-secondary institution or registered with The Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training Board or any approved equivalent Canadian or U.S. Apprenticeship board, in the fall immediately following his/her graduation,
- o Proof of payment for the above program, and
- Application form (example attached as Appendix A) is completed in full & submitted for consideration to the NCSA Board on or before the NCSA Board Meeting in October of the Swimmer Applicant's graduating year.

3 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

All scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Executive Board and Head Coach.
