

# NWT swimming Games Coach's/Managers selection criteria

This form is to be completed by any person wishing to be nominated for selection as either a Coach or manager for NWT swimming at participating Games.

### Coaches: For 2023 North American Indigenous Games

The Head coach should be swim 201 trained and assistant coach swim 101 certified and having completed all the NCCP requirements as established by the Games council. Coaches should be actively coaching prior to the Games. Where possible preference will be given to coaches of Indigenous descent. The highest qualified coach shall be named as Head Coach. A coach of both genders shall be named to the Team. In the event that there are only 2 coaches of the same sex available the manager shall be of the opposite sex and Games Council approval shall be required as outlined in the 2020 Technical package

All coaches must be a member of the CSCTA, Swimming Canada and their Provincial /Territorial Swimming Coaches Association and have completed all prerequisites.

Coaches applying that meet the above criteria (1 per gender) will be selected on a rotational basis. The number of coaches selected will be identified by the Games council Coaches will be identified by the NWT Technical Director and sanctioned by the NWT board of directors.

Managers will be selected on a club rotational basis if more than 1 candidate applies. Managers must comply with all criteria laid down by the Games Council.

### Coach /manager development remains a top priority for future games.

This form is to be completed by any person wishing to be nominated for selection as either a coach or manager for NWT swimming at participating Games. **by January 1, 2023** 

#### To be eligible for nomination, a person must:

• Be of legal age



- Be a resident of Canada and preferably the NWT
- Have the endorsement of their club or Nominations Committee

Have a sound venerable sector and criminal records check

Meet all relevant criteria as stipulated by the Games committee and Meet Package

Be knowledgeable of the Organizations Policies, Procedures, Morals and Ethics

Be prepared to train/manage the athletes prior to and during the Games.

Collaborate with coaches/manager in a team environment comprising of athletes of either gender.
