NWT swimming CODE OF CONDUCT

All swimmers are required to read and sign the Code of Conduct form prior to swimming for Team NWT . Parents/Guardians are encouraged to review and discuss the CODE with their swimmer(s).

CODE OF CONDUCT

Members of the NWT swimming association include swimmers, coaches, officials, parents and board members fall under and are bound by the swim Alberta code of conduct as affiliates . You, as a swimmer, are the most visible part of the Territory. All members are ambassadors for competitive swimming, sport ,your home towns, clubs and the Northwest Territories. You gain many benefits from your participation in organized competitive swimming therefor your participation brings with it some responsibilities. These responsibilities include the following:

1. At all times be courteous and helpful to team mates, coaches, other swimmers, officials and the general public. Coaches and Team management must be obeyed at all times and may act in''loco parentis'' during NWT events .Team management will be responsible for all team members during any NWT camp , clinic or team event .

2. Participate according to the rules and in the spirit of fair play .

3. Adhere to any regulations that are established during competitions. These might include curfews; nutritional guidelines and other rules designed for safety and to maximize the benefits of participation. Members will be advised of regulations on a periodic basis.

4. Participate in all team activities and strive to build team spirit.

- 5. Lead a positive alcohol, tobacco and drug free life style. Regardless of age recreational drugs, tobacco and alcohol products are not allowed during any NWT/swim Alberta event.
- 6. Be aware that you may be subject to random drug tests without notice if you achieve certain levels within the sport. Education programs will be provided at appropriate times.
- 7. Be punctual at all

times.

- 8. Make restitution for any personal or property damage caused during any events.
- 9. Remain at competitions for award presentations, banquets and other events unless previous arrangements have been made.

10. Wear team uniforms when requested to do so.

Members unable to comply with these responsibilities of the Code of Conduct may be subject to disciplinary action up to and including suspension from activities, their immediate return home at their own cost and/or removal from the Association .

Having read and understood the above NWT Code of Conduct, I agree and comply as a member in good standing, and I will accept full responsibility for any injury or consequence due to neglect of the Rules and Regulations.
