

OSAC Points System

Families must earn a minimum number of points in a swim season (Points based on **oldest** family swimmer only)

Swim Group:

Comp Bronze, Silver, Gold	20
Comp Blue	17
Waves, Tides	15
Development	10
Splash	2 points per session

20 points is equivalent to \$200

Families will be asked to collect the required points for their oldest swimmer.

Failure to earn minimum points will result in a charge to the credit card associated with the swimmer's account. 1 unearned point is equivalent to a \$10 charge.

After completing volunteer hours, members can submit their points using the google form.

Ways to earn points:

*Safety Marshall at swim meet	2 points
*Volunteer 1 session at any swim meet	4 points
*Volunteer 1 session at any swim meet (that your child is not attending)	6 points
*Volunteer at Splashorama	2 points
*Volunteer during an OSAC social event	2 points
*Help organize a Social Event (before, during, after)	5 points
*Take an official's clinic	7 points (level 1 - Intro to swim officiating clinic, safety marshal clinic)

	10 points (level 2 or higher - strokes and turns, chief timer, clerk of course, starter, referee, chief finish judge, recorder scorer, electronics/colorado system operator)
*Organize an OSAC fundraising event	15 points
*Volunteer at Triathlon	2 points
*Run an official's clinic	10 points
*Chaperone a travel meet	10 points
*OSAC Sub Committee	10 points
*OSAC board position (non-executive)	15 points
*OSAC board position (executive)	20 points
*Volunteer parent coach	15 points
*Other volunteer roles	determined by board

You are responsible for submitting your volunteer points using the link above. You can submit points at any time and multiple times through the year. All points must be submitted by the end of the swim season. OSAC will communicate with families regarding points required to complete season. VP, President and Treasurer shall determine amounts owing by families by June 30 of each season.
