




• Log in or create an account (http://saskatoonaqualenes.rampregistrations.com/)



- Make note of your log-in information for future access.
- Once you've created an account, you can log-in and register your athlete(s).
- You'll first need to verify your account. A 6 digit code will be sent to your email address;
 enter it in the "Code" line click submit:




- You'll be taken to the welcome page:
 - Note: You'll be asked to familiarize yourself with the SAQ Registration Manual. It's important to read as many of your questions will be addressed in it as well as important information to be aware of as a member of SAQ (i.e. parent volunteer requirements/fees, costs/fees charged associated with competitions for provincial and national stream athletes, etc...). The manual is also on the SAQ website and can be referred to anytime.
 - o From here, click on "Participant" to enter your athlete's information:



- o Ensure the correct season is activated (e.g. 2024-2025)
- o In the "Choose Account Member to Register as a Participant" drop-down box, select "Add an account member" (do this for each athlete and parent who will be volunteering)






- From the "Choose a Division" drop-down menu, select the division from the (Note: age is based on what they'll be on 31 Dec 2025).
 - Recreational swimmer = Aquagiggles (born 2017 2019) or Recreational swimmer (born 2011 2017)
 - Limited Stream (10U born 2015 2018; 14U born 2011 2014)
 - Provincial Stream (10U born 2015 2016; 12U born 2013 2014, Youth/Junior born 2007 2012)
 - National Stream (12U born 2013 2014; Youth born 2010 2012; Junior born 2006 2009)
 - Senior/Masters = born 2006 or earlier
- From the "Choose Your Program" drop-down, select the program to register into (Note: if your athlete is in a competitive program (Ltd Comp, PS, or NS), you will also need to select the "Additional fees" box to continue with registration)




- Once a program is selected, more boxes will appear at the bottom of the screen; from the "Choose Your Package" select one:
 - Please note: there will be two options for the same group based on payment method. The payment plan is outlined and will automatically be charged to your credit card on the dates indicated. If paying bi-annually or monthly, the initial payment is higher to cover the Canadian Artistic Swimming (CAS) affiliation cost that is required to register. There will be one for full/bi-annual payments, and one for monthly payments. Select the one that you wish to use.




There is a membership fee of \$56.00 (CAD). The fee will be paid to Canada Artistic Swimming for CAS Member Fees.

- There will be an orange banner at the bottom of the screen indicating the SAS and CAS fees due separately for the division selected. These will vary depending on the program your swimmer is in and are paid separately by credit card or etransfer:
 - If paying by credit card, continue with the registration and the fees will be charged to your card.
 - If paying by etransfer, the payments must be submitted separately to
 - SAS via <u>payment@saskartisticswimming.ca</u> with the security response set as "None" (Note: Include your swimmer's name in the notes and SAQ club)
 - CAS is set up to accept credit card payments only
- o Continue
- You'll be taken to the next page where the athlete guardian(s) are entered (you can add an additional guardian).



You'll be taken through a series of questions required by Canadian Artistic Swimming (CAS). Complete based on the athlete being registered.

• Select the check box regarding the Pre-Season Education Concussion form for CAS



- You'll be taken to the waivers section where you sign digitally for each (the media waiver is the only optional one. If you do not consent to media usage, simply check the appropriate box.)
 - At the bottom of the waiver page, check the box if you are the parent/guardian of the minor



- o Continue
- Select all that apply in the next window





- Continue
- Next a page will display confirmation of the information provided and allow you to submit registration
 - o Double check the information captured and edit as needed
 - Enter payment information. For the payment in full or bi-annual, the default will be biannual.
 - Note: to prevent being charged the "Additional fees" at registration but wanting to pay in full, you will need to complete a few more steps. DO NOT check the box under the credit card information, shown here:




- You'll need to "Submit Registration"
- Complete partial payment information (Note: make note of the balance remaining for the package only. Once registration is complete, you can log back in and manually submit the remaining package payment)

Once the payment has been processed, you'll receive a notice indicating your registration has been successful. You will also receive a confirmation email with a summary of our refund policy.


Event/Volunteer Registration

* Note – for insurance purposes, this will need to be done for each family member who volunteers throughout the season. If you are a member of the Executive and will also be volunteering, you need to register for both and pay the higher fee (to CAS). Criminal record checks are only required if you will be chaperoning athletes during the season.


Volunteer payments will be paid by SAQ to SAS, so you do not have to submit the \$3 by etransfer

Go to the "Dashboard" (select from left menu)


- Ensure the correct season is activated (e.g. 2024-2025)
- In the "Executive/Volunteer Registration" drop-down box, select "Volunteer Member" from the "Position" drop-down menu (if registering as Executive, select "Associate Registrant")



 Then select the Account Member (do this for each parent/family member who will be volunteering):



- Ensure the information is complete and accurate
 - o Continue
 - There is a \$3 membership fee for each volunteer payable to SAS <u>by etransfer</u> however
 SAQ will cover this cost (you do not have to submit payment via etransfer)
 - There is a \$10 membership fee **for each Executive member** (this is the only fee you pay even if also volunteering) payable <u>by credit card to CAS</u> (SAQ will reimburse you)
- Vulnerable sector screening and Criminal record check screen (only required if you will be chaperoning athletes during the system, otherwise bypass and click "Continue")
 - If you have completed, are part of the Executive, Coaches and/or will be a chaperone, enter the "Dates Completed" of the two screening checks (the VSS file is optional)

Coach/Staff Registration






- Make note of your log-in information for future access.

- You'll be taken to the welcome page:
 - o From here, click on "Coach/Staff Registration" to enter your information:

- Select the "Preferred Division(s) and Position(s)
 - Once selected, a second drop-down box will display for your to "Choose your role"
