

WELCOME TO THE SWIMMING CANADA E-LEARNING SYSTEM

Important: Please read the following instructions before starting an online course:

1. Click on the SESSION Button to see the full list of online courses. Each e-module will take about 30 minutes and includes activities and a quiz to test what you are learning. The e-module includes audio, so please don't forget to turn up the volume on your computer or tablet. If you are using a smartphone, please ensure the mute button or ringer is set to "on". Please note that if you are using a tablet, you may be required to download an app (ex: Articulate Mobile Player) in order to play the e-module. We recommend that you have the Swimming Canada rule book available to reference or research whether it be in printed format or [online](#).
2. If you would like to begin taking the e-modules, please click on the ENROLL button.
3. The e-modules will appear under SESSION. You have the option to complete each online course over one or more sessions. The E-Module will automatically start where you left off. Please note that you can only resume a course on the same electronic device and in the selected language.
4. Once you have registered for a course, the STATUS section will show that you are ENROLLED and IN PROGRESS. Once the online course is completed, a green check mark will appear under COMPLETED and you will now be listed as QUALIFIED.
5. Once you have completed the e-module, please click the FINISH button on last slide in order to complete the course. Once the FINISH button is clicked, your Swimming Canada online registration system account will be automatically updated. Your account will show that you have completed the clinic online.
