

Team Travel Checklist

Athletes:

- 1. Must have team warm up to travel to and from the meet.
- 2. Should bring cell phones.

Parents:

- 1. Sign travel policy form
- 2. Sign consent forms/ release forms
- 3. Sign medical forms
- 4. Sign room assignments form
- 5. Meal plan to be advised
- 6. Consent to pay fees associated.
- 7. Chaperones notification and contact letter
- 8. What to pack guide/ Team Warm Ups
- 9. All athletes travel in Team warm Ups
- 10. Advise of any allergies or medical conditions/ do they carry treatment/ do they know how to administer in such event
- 11. Sleeping arrangement notice

Bussing Company:

- 1. Copy of insurance and Policy Coverage
- 2. Gas and miles included
- 3. Room and board for driver or just room
- 4. Driving record of driver
- 5. Maintenance records of vehicle
- 6. Breakdown Policies
 - a. How long till recovery
 - b. Does it cover loss of families and clubs investments if meet is missed (athlete fee to go to meet, coaches fee room and board)
 - c. Safety policies in the event of a breakdown
- 7. Is driver employee or is it a 1099 for hire driver
- 8. What background checks are done for drivers
- 9. Is Driver CPR certified/ is there a full first Aid kit on bus/ AED kit/ Fire extinguishers

- 10. What is the claim process if needs to be filed and time to recover any claims
- 11. Year the bus was built
- 12. Mechanical records of bus

USA Swimming:

- 1. Notify Insurance department of travel dates and modes of transportation via email and confirmation
- 2. Supply USA with the bussing contract and coverage of insurance
- 3. Confirm that USA Travel Insurance will be in tack 25,000.00 policy
- 4. Request any forms they have on team travel, Medical, Liability etc.
- 5. If any extra-curricular events are to happen such as a trip to a theme park or rock climbing, or hike or rafting request and additional rider of coverage. Usually cost 100.00

Coaches:

- 1. Must never enter the room of any athlete without a chaperone.
- 2. Coaches rooms must never be adjoining rooms
- 3. Coaches must all sign the Coaches Code of Conduct and Safe Sport agreement
- 4. Coaches never have in their possession keys, fobs or magnetic cards to enter any room other then their own and or a community Team room.

Chaperones:

- 1. Must be and Adult Participant as defined by USA Swimming (Non athlete member, APT, MAAPP, Level 2 background check)
- 2. Must have a valid drivers license
- 3. Must sign the Chaperone Code of Conduct
