Air Quality Policy Last Updated on June 30, 2023

OVERVIEW

For the health and safety of our swimmers, coaches, parents, and fellow staff members at the San Dimas Recreation Center, San Dimas Aquatics will do the following to prevent exposures to unhealthy air quality.

PROCEDURES

- Monitor the EPA AIRNow App daily.
- Cancel practice if the Air Quality Index (AQI) is 180 or higher. An AQI of 180 falls within the
 unhealthy range for swimmers according to the AIRNow App and Southern California Swimming's
 Operational Risk Committee.
- Cancel practice within two hours before it starts.
 - If in the situation the air quality rises to 180 either within that two-hour frame or during practice, coaches must make the executive decision to cancel practice.
- Message parents and guardians via Remind whenever an air quality concern arises.
