Environmental Hazards Policy

OVERVIEW

For the health and safety of our swimmers, coaches, parents, and fellow staff members at the San Dimas Recreation Center, San Dimas Aquatics will do the following in response to environmental hazards.

PROCEDURES

I. Thunder & Lightning

- If thunder and/or lightning is detected, swimmers must exit the pool safely and wait 30 minutes to pass in order to re-enter the water safely.
- If thunder and/or lightning is detected during the 30-minute period, then practice will be canceled.

II. Chlorine Levels

- According to the Water Quality & Health Council, if chlorine in the water exceeds 5 ppm, practice must be canceled.
- Water must be checked regularly by San Dimas Recreation Center Staff throughout the day.
