To Taste Experience

22 of our swimmers reached out eagerly and without fear to experience the challenge of competing in the RAA Last Ditch JAG swim meet held the first week of June. JAG is the June Age Group LCM (long course meters) championships held in the middle of June. A week or 2 before the championships a 'last ditch' meet is held for those swimmers trying one last time to get those really hard to get JAG qualifying times.

Our swimmers tasted the experience of competing at their best. And they did very well.

Our 22 swimmers competed in 93 events, achieving:

- 13 new C times;
- 6 new B times:
- 13 new BB times;
- 4 new A times

OUTSTANDING SWIMS

Giancarlo Carbajal, Pre-Senior, dominated, swimming all 6 events with BB times or better and setting the TEAM RECORD for his 400 FREE. His 100 Fly and 400 Free were both FIRST TIME BB TIMES. His 50 Free and 100 Free are NEW A TIMES. He dropped time in all 6 events for a total -8.73 and all 6 swims are in the TOP 10 times.

Joshua Salgado, Junior, also had a fantastic meet, swimming all 5 events with BB times and 1 event with a B time. He dropped time in all 6 events and was BEST TOTAL TIME DROP with a whopping -21.43. His 400 Free was a TEAM RECORD and a FIRST TIME BB TIME, his 100 Fly and 200 Free were NEW BB TIMES, and his 200 Fly was a NEW B TIME. All 6 swims are in the TOP 10 times.

Continuing to Have Outstanding Swims

Connor McAleer, Junior, continues to amaze, earning FIRST TIME BB TIMES in ALL 4 events: 100 Fly, 100 Free, 200 IM, and the 400 Free. His 200 IM was a new TEAM RECORD. All 4 swims are in the TOP 10 times

Ellie Devine, Junior, set new TEAM RECORDS for her 100 Fly and 50 Free, got a FIRST TIME BB TIME for her 100 Fly, and a NEW A TIME for her 100 Free. Ellie was also our TOP POINTS with 73.
