1 CCCAN qualification tournament in 2016 for the age group 16u. for the UANA Youth Championships in 2017

**TWPC proposal to the CCCAN Exec.: Look into the possibility of hosting this event by one of the following CAMEX countries: CRC, PAN or GUA.**

Motivation: their initiatives to develop water polo in their country and the fact that the CCCAN Championships 2015 and 2017 are held in the Caribbean.

This event could be hosted either in connection with the upcoming CAMEX Championships or hosted separately.

Remarks by IG:

He is taking initiatives for further cooperation in development of water polo in the CAMEX countries

CAMEX could be open in the future for other Latin-American and Caribbean countries.

He advises to look into the possibilities for (short) development clinics in our area by TWPC members.

2 Adding 1 extra competition day to the CCCAN Water Polo events and having the Technical Congress the night before.

Due to the fact that the competition program including technical meet leaves hardly any space for extension and will cause great complications in case of delay (due to for example power failure, extreme weather etc.)

**TWPC proposal to the CCCAN Exec.: Add 1 (one) day of competition to a total of 5 (five) and plan the Technical Congress the night not before 20:00 hrs.**

3 Eligibility to participate at UANA Youth/Junior events and CAC Games.

To enforce participation in the CCCAN qualification events is must be obligatory to participate in these events to be eligible to qualify for the before mentioned UANA Championships and CAC Games.

**TWPC proposal to the CCCAN Exec.: countries will only be eligible to be nominated for UANA events and CAC Games if they have participated in the CCCAN qualification event**

Remarks from LR:

If this proposal is accepted by the CCAN Exec. he wants to have this proposal communicated to all countries as soon as possible and the option that the Exec. will review in case of exceptional and/or emergency situations.

4 2016 event for Senior (Open) category.

In 2017 at the Fina WCH in Budapest, the water polo family will vote on the test rules which are used now at Youth and Junior level and Fina World league.

In our area there has not been any Senior (Open) category event where these rules were tested.

**TWPC proposal to the CCCAN Exec.: Organize, in connection with the 16u CCCAN qualification tournament, a tournament for the category Senior (Open) applying the test rules with the exceptions dictated by Fina for the 2016 World League competition.**

5 Referees

Due to the fact that there are countries not bringing any water polo referee at CCCAN water polo events, there are complications running the competition with impartial referees.

**TWPC proposal to the CCCAN Exec.: Enforce the obligation for a country participating in a CCCAN Water Polo event, to bring at least 1 (one) referee. This referee does not have to be a Fina listed referee.**
