Dear Friends.

We have the pleasure to inform you that FINA will organise **FINA** Artistic Swimming Schools in 2020.

Please note the following information related to the courses and the designation of FINA Artistic Swimming Judges:

- All the FINA Artistic Swimming Schools will be held over a duration of three (3) days.
- > The official working language for FINA Artistic Swimming Schools is English.
- > The FINA Artistic Swimming Development Schools are open to all the National Federations interested in developing judges that are not on the current FINA List. They are available at three different levels: beginner, intermediate or advanced.
- ➤ The FINA Artistic Swimming Certification Schools are for those judges on the current FINA List. They are designed to prepare and certify highly qualified FINA List judges in the A or G category.
- Please note that to be considered for judging at a FINA competition, a judge must have successfully passed the judges exam administered at one of the FINA Artistic Swimming Certification Schools every four years.
- In addition, each FINA certified judge must annually pass the Online FINA Artistic Swimming - Exam for Certified Judges.

We invite you to carefully read the FINA Artistic Swimming Judges Certification Pathway for any further information.

Please kindly note that FINA will accept bids for the organisation of the Artistic Swimming Schools until **September 15, 2019**.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you about the following requirements for their organisation:

1. Bid Procedure

Any National Federation may present a bid to host a FINA Artistic Swimming Development or Certification School by sending the attached form duly completed to schools@fina.org

Please name your application as follows: 2020 FINA AS Development (or) Certification School / NF Code

According to our procedures, only duly signed and stamped applications will be assessed.

2. Federation Requirements

The following requirements must be met by the Host Federation in order to organise a FINA Artistic Swimming School:

FINA Artistic Swimming Development Schools

- a) A conference room with enough capacity for the participants and presentation equipment (power point projector, screen, laptop, DVD player, white board and microphones).
- b) At least ten (10) <u>eligible judges</u> (aged 18-65 years old) must attend in order to host a Development School. The maximum number of participants is thirty (30).
- c) Coaches may register as Observers and fill any remaining spots as established in the <u>FINA AS Manual 2017-2021</u>.

FINA Artistic Swimming Certification Schools

- a) A conference room with enough capacity for the participants and presentation equipment (power point projector, screen, laptop, DVD player, white board and microphones).
- b) At least ten (10) <u>FINA Judges</u> must attend in order to host a Certification School. The maximum number of participants is thirty (30).
- FINA age eligible judges (65 years old and under) and active national level coaches may register as Observers and fill any
