Dear Friends,

We have the pleasure to inform you that FINA will organise **FINA Diving Schools for Judges** in 2020:

- The FINA Diving Development Schools for Judges are designed for individuals with limited basic knowledge or no prior diving judge's experience. They are held over held over a duration of two (2) days.
- The FINA Diving Certification Schools for Judges are designed for experienced judges taking this course for the first time or for judges who are seeking to renew their FINA Diving Judges Certification. They are held over held over a duration of three (3) days.

We invite you to carefully read the <u>2019-2021 Diving Certification Pathway</u> for any further information.

Please kindly note that FINA will accept bids for the organisation of Diving Schools for Judges until **September 15, 2019**.

Once the National Federations have submitted their bid applications, the FINA Technical Diving Committee will recommend which schools shall be hosted among the proposals received.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you about the following requirements for their organisation:

#### 2. Federation Requirements

The following requirements must be met by the Host Federation in order to organise a FINA Diving School:

#### FINA Diving Development School for Judges

- a) At least ten (10) participants must attend in order to host a Development School. The maximum number of participants is thirty (30).
- b) A conference room with enough capacity for the participants and presentation equipment (power point projector, screen, laptop, DVD player, white board and microphones).

# FINA Diving Certification School for Judges

- a) At least ten (10) participants must attend in order to host a Certification School. The maximum number of participants is thirty (30).
- b) A conference room with enough capacity for the participants and presentation equipment (power point projector, screen, laptop, DVD player, white board and microphones).
- c) A facility which has a pool capable of supporting diving competitions with space for judges panels as well as shadow judges panels.
- d) A diving competition in which the participants will be observed by the clinicians. The competition should last two (2) days and must comprise diving competitions in springboard, platform and synchronized diving.

## 30th August – 15th September:

The bidding period is open for all the National Federations, which are invited to send their bid applications to the FINA Office until September 15, 2019.

#### 16<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> September:

The bids are assessed by the FINA Technical Diving Committee.
