Central Zone Officials Chair Report

The Central Zone continued to make progress with assigning Meet Referees from outside host LSCs. At the LSC Officials Chairs meeting in Houston last year the CZ Chairs agreed that although they could provide opportunities within their LSCs, to advance people to the next level we needed to work cooperatively. Having a more formal development process for Sectional and Zone MRs would ensure that there were opportunities made available for deserving candidates. This is the first full year we have been operating under those principles.

- Looking for candidates who have extensive experience at Sectional and Zone meets
- LSC Championship (prelim/final) MR experience
- N3 DR preferred
- National experience desired (it's hard to create a national deck experience if you don't know what it is)
- Strive to assign people OUTSIDE their home LSC.
- Breaks away from home pool/regular meet mentality. Referees bring their "A Game" if they are not in their regular pool
- Not had an out of LSC meet in the last 3-5 years

Hopefully we have set the path for continued opportunities for officials to advance, be supported, and gain opportunities both within and outside their LSCs.

Biannual calls with the Sectional Chairs began this year. The goal of the calls includes the following:

- develop not only an environment of excellence but also how the sections can help to build the next generation of officials.
- talk about up-and-coming referees and work together to plan for upcoming meets

Separately, the Central Zone officials chair and vice-chair will work with the Central Zone Championship meet coordinators to develop a process for advancing officials in the CZ. This may include:

- choosing Zone referees
- ways to support officials attending the Zone Meets,
- developing guidelines such as:
 - what it takes to be a zone referee,
 - requirements in meet bids about evaluators,
 - requirements to secure free rooms,
 - budget to allow zone officials chairs to be reimbursed for attending meets

This year we canceled the \$200/year Officials Application service we were using for Sectional and Zone meets. We gained several benefits from migrating to Google Forms:

- Meet Referee (and anyone they designate) is notified whenever an application is submitted
- Officials receive an immediate notification of receipt
- Submission can be edited at any time
- Meet Referee has direct access to all the data at their convenience

Thanks to Marianne Walling from IN who set up the meets.

Once again CZ Meets, both Sectionals and Zones, brought in high caliber national evaluators who were able to cover many, if not all, evaluation requests. Most OQMs could mentor positions through N3final evaluations at all positions.
