CENTRAL ZONE BOARD OF REVIEW

- 1. Central Zone Board of Review Named Positions were as follows for the 2016-17 year:
 - a. Chair Beverly Brister
 - b. Secretary Chris McCrary
 - c. Former Co-Chair Brian Schaenzer moved and was no longer eligible to serve on the Board of Review.
 - d. Former Vice-Chair Kim Stoll rotated off of the Board of Review.
- 2. The current terms for the LSC Board of Review Members are shown below. Each LSC will appoint one athlete and one non-athlete. Non-athlete terms will last for three years after the initial, staggered (one, two, or three year) term. This is the final year for the staggered term.
 - a. The WI, AR, OH, OK, and OZ LSCs will need to appoint (or reappoint) Board of Review Members for a three-year term for the 2018 year.
 - b. The IA, ND, MI, IN, and MN Board of Review Members will need to appoint (or re-appointed) for a three-year term effective with the 2019 year.
 - c. The IL, LE, MW, MV, and SD LSCs appointed Board of Review Members for the 2017 year and will need to appoint (or reappoint) Board of Review Members for a three-year term effective with the 2020 year.
- 3. Necessary re-appointments were submitted to Amy Hoppenrath in early August, so that the LSCs could be notified prior to the convention.
- 4. For the 2016-2017 period, two Board of Review petitions were filed in the Central Zone. A hearing was conducted in one case, and a written decision was issued. Beverly Brister was the Presiding Chair.
 - a. The Hearing was conducted via telephone conference.
 - b. A panel of three members (one athlete member and two non-athlete members) was selected for the case presented.
- 5. Board of Review Hearing Panels (established previously by random selection) remained the same.

Note: Panels are selected on a rotating basis, eliminating members in the same LSC as the Petitioner/Respondent.

6. The Board of Review did not hear the second case. The second case was dismissed by the Chair, Beverly Brister, via written dismissal pursuant to the 2017 USA Swimming Rulebook Rules and Regulations.
