Facility: 10 lane competition pool. Good water depth, excellent scoreboard, graphics, Colorado Timing System, High quality sound system. Announcer receives high marks for outstanding work. Club coach who was very professional, energetic, very knowledgeable with swim meet process, worked well with admin. staff on time lines for prelims and finals session especially awards process for both 10& under and older kids sessions.

Host: Excellent meet operational capability allows for experienced computer operations, timing system operators, hospitality very proficient use of email and web based communication, meet reports, meet publications available in hardcopy or online promptly every session. High marks for use of web based host site to communicate and direct attendees. Full length venue seating, ample deck space, seating for athletes, adequate lighting could be improved a bit. Venue air quality excellent, water quality and clarity high marks, good water temp. warm up warm down venue area due to facility patrons using the rec center during the meet put some stress on the venue, excellent hospitality area, meeting room for officials briefing and planning, awards stand and presentation good, parade staging area very good, on site publication copiers & office equipment very good, medals very good design and art work, plentiful parking areas for cars and buses, great location park siting/lake area one of the nicest in the zone, lodging Kenosha and Pleasant Prairie large number of restaurants close, excellent interstate access.


Sessions: Ran smooth, on time line each session. Prelim sessions length 3 hours very well accepted, 10-under session ran on time each session, pace of competition and awards measured and consistent, ample awards presentation time with photo opportunities. 1-8 medals, 9-16 ribbons, relays 1-3. 1-8 medals presented on podium. Adjusted awards session from presentation by age group to presentation by stroke. This change allowed more predictable timeline management. Excellent team work between admin staff and meet operations to coordinate the awards process so that it was a good experience for athletes and spectators. Finals time line very good by Day 2.

There were 44 working officials in attendance. The national evaluator was Eric Peterson-IL. LSCs represented were: IL., IN., OK., WI., SD., IA., and MW.17 evaluations were completed.

Facility design allowed for separation of athlete entrance to locker rooms and competition pool and spectators. Public restrooms separated from athlete locker/changing areas. Very good control of access to the competition area. Might consider athlete drinking water stations added to the deck area. Host had post meet results reports distributed to the attending LSC contacts immediately after the awards presentations. Attendance at the meet of a medal engraver was a benefit/plus not common to these events. Typical action photography, apparel and swim shop vendors on site. No online admission /publication ticket purchases or online event apparel.



Q1 What best describes your role in attending the meet?





Q2 Pre-meet information and entry process





Q3 The air quality





Q4 The seating and view of the pool









Q7 The Video Board and or scoreboard





Q8 Walk from drop off/parking area to the pool





Q9 Parking Cost







Q11 The Announcer (knowledge, excitement, clarity)





Q12 The level of competition





Q13 The time between prelims and finals





Q14 The pace of competition for prelims and finals





Q15 The athlete seating and deck space







Q17 Timing System





Q18 The Timing System - Functioning & Visible





Q19 The Starter (easy to hear and understand)





Q20 The warm up-warm down pool, water temperature, clarity, lighting











Q4 The seating and view of the pool









Q8 Walk from drop off/parking area to the pool











Q14 The pace of competition for prelims and finals





Q15 The athlete seating and deck space









Q18 The Timing System - Functioning & Visible








