Central Zone Diversity Coordinator Report

June 10-11, 2017

Purpose and Goal

The purpose of the Central Zone Multi-Cultural Meet is stated as follows:

An initiative to embrace and celebrate our own diversity, and to allow the success of competitive goals, establish friendships, learn from one another, and share the love of our sport...... Swimming.

The goals were as follows:

- To create an opportunity of competitive success for all athletes.
- To establish and maintain decorum of the championship meet environment.
- To introduce athletes to guest Olympians and speakers to share their culture, goals, competitive successes and stories.
- To create camaraderie and communication among coaching staffs and officials from all attending LSCs.
- To allow an opportunity for the LSC Diversity Coordinators to meet, exchange ideas and evaluate the Multi-Cultural events for the Central Zone.

Funding

The funding for this event came from various sources, but a good portion of the outlay came from the Ohio State Swim Club.

The host club donated and paid for the following:

- Pool and facility rental costs
- Hospitality food and beverages
- Athlete and parent Multi-Cultural Luncheon- fee was charged per attendee however for any Outreach Athlete this fee was waived
- Entry fees for Outreach Athletes were waived
- Medals and ribbons
- Bag Tags for all attending athletes, coaches and event staff
- Coupon for each athlete to receive one free meet t-shirt from the vendor at the meet

Central Zone provided \$3000.00 to the meet host and USA Swimming provided \$5000.00.

USA Swimming provided the following:

- Make A Splash handouts and pins
- USA Swimming tattoos and pins
- Speedo back packs for prizes
- Guest Speaker Sabir Muhammad

Meet entry fees, lodging, meals and transportation were the responsibility of each LSC, as done with the 14 and Under Central Zone Meet.

Summary:

It is apparent that attendance increased dramatically for the 2017 meet mostly influenced by the host LSC.

Goal:

Previously the goal was to increase participation numbers which was accomplished. Many LSCs increased their athlete attendance while some decreased. We will now have to communicate with the LSCs who increased their athlete numbers to gain some perspective on how they promoted the meet within their LSC to share with all LSCs.

Meet Administration

Christine Thompson, Director of Aquatic Events & Buckeye Aquatic Academy must be commended on how well the entries went this year. In addition, Ohio State Swim Club's website was set up to receive on line payments for entries. This enabled the host to receive prompt payments. As stated before, the host club waived all entry fees for registered Outreach Athletes. The communication between the host and participating LSCs was excellent and timely. Many thanks again to Christine Thompson and her volunteers.

Competitive Event

As previously reported after the 2015 Multi-Cultural meet the relays were changed to 12 and Under, 14 and Under and 15 and Over. Prior to the meet one LSC commented that they were under the impression that the 15 and Over relays were to be Open. In reviewing all notes, I could not find where this was decided upon at the last Multi-Cultural Meet Diversity Coordinators meeting. In the essence of fairness Christine Thompson, myself and Terry Anchrum (Meet Referee) decided that a notice would go out to all participating LSCs to vote on the proposed change from 15 and Over relays to Open relays with all having to agree in order to make the change to the meet format. The change was not accepted and the relays continued with the 15 and Over format.

Athlete Special Events

Sabir Muhammad was our guest speaker for the event and spent the majority of Saturday at the venue on deck. The Ohio State University swim team members and Sabir Muhammad created a relay and participated in a race against all LSCs who made up their relay team from participating athletes. He was also the featured speaker at the Athlete/Parent dinner luncheon with approximately 500 attendees. This event had previously been scheduled as a dinner, but was so well received that a decision was made to change it to a luncheon. All LSCs agreed to the adjusted timeline which involved delaying the afternoon session warm ups.

On Sunday, the theme was NCAA day to take advantage of having a venue on a college campus. Christine Thompson's idea of requesting the college swimmers to be "Ambassadors" of the sport was well received. College swimmers were asked to come and engage the athletes in conversations about their journey to college swimming and the positive influences they had along the way. They also served as "cheerleaders", timers and award presenters. Bill Wadley (recently retired Head Coach of Ohio State University) also made an appearance on deck along with Sam and Amanda two Olympians.

LSC Diversity Coordinators Meeting

This meeting took place on Sunday afternoon. Several issues were addressed with the following agreed upon solutions in regard to the Multi-Cultural Meet:

- 15 and Over Relays will now be Open Relays
- One additional Mixed Gender Relay will be added under each age group
- Recommendation to move the dinner to a luncheon was accepted and will be noted to future hosts

There was also a recommendation for the 2018 Diversity Camp to increase the number of participants each LSC could bring to the camp. Todd Billhimer, Mason Manta Rays, 2018 host Diversity Camp Coordinator arrived for a meeting with myself and Manny Banks during the Multi-Cultural Meet. It was decided that each LSC may bring 4 athletes versus the previous 2 athletes along with naming 2 Alternates. The alternates may attend if the limit of 4 athletes per CZ LSC is not met. LSCs will be notified and may fill the remaining openings on a first come-first serve basis.

Comments

These comments are difficult to address but need to be noted in this report. These are not issues of right or wrong, but of perspective. Emails were received by the host and myself commenting on the visual perception of the lack of diversity during the meet. Here is a comment from an athlete who was asked by her home coach how the meet went: "It was okay, but there were mostly white kids there." The coach went on to explain that diversity was more than color: the athletes could have a different ethnic background, economic situation, or even sexual orientation. The response was: "They didn't seem very diverse, it felt like any other swim meet." The other comments ran along the same lines. I believe now, we will need to make this a discussion point. We may not have the solutions but we can discuss how to invest in a more diverse environment moving forward.
