

CUDA Senior 2

Senior 2 swimmers are knowledgeable of the four competitive strokes and have an intermediate grasp on aerobic training. A senior 2 swimmer is working towards qualifying for State, Senior Zones and Sectionals. Front Range Barracudas offers 6 practices a week for Senior group. It is encouraged that swimmers in this group commit to consistently making at least 4 workouts per week, and 2 per week during High School season.

Practices- 6 pool practices a week for 1.75 to 2.0 hours.

Dryland- 2 x 45-minute dryland sessions per week.

Meets- Participation in monthly USA-sanctioned swim meets is expected. Championship meets for this group include Northern Colorado Championships, State, and Seniors Zones.

Age- The age range for Senior group swimmers is 13-18 years old.

Minimum requirements- Senior 2 group swimmers should be able to complete the following sets and meet the standards set forth in the CUDA group promotion philosophy.

10 x 100 Free @ 1:25

8 x100 IM @ 1:35

Group Size- Senior group ranges in size from 20-28 athletes per practice.

Equipment: is used to promote proper technique in different areas. Your coach will communicate which days equipment will be needed. The following pieces of equipment are used or introduced in Senior group:

- Water Bottle
- Kickboards
- Fins
- Snorkel
- Paddles
- Practice suit
- Coaches will provide any other equipment used
