Dear Hamden Hall Community:

We continue to place the health and safety of our school community as our top priority. As such, we are abiding by the State of Connecticut's Travel Advisory for out-of-state travel. Should you need to travel, please refer to the Hamden Hall Travel Policy below.

Hamden Hall Country Day School Travel Policy

If a Hamden Hall student, faculty or staff member travels to an area that is included on the State of CT travel advisory list, the following steps are required in order to return to any of the Hamden Hall campuses:

- 1. Hamden Hall must be notified of any travel plans including the dates of travel and destination.
- 2. Upon return the student, faculty or staff member shall quarantine at home for a 5-7 day period and make arrangements with their primary care physician to be tested for Covid-19 once that time period is completed.
- 3. The Covid-19 test must be a PCR test.
- 4. The student, faculty or staff member must remain home in quarantine until the test results are available.
- 5. If the test results are negative and Hamden Hall has been notified, the student, faculty or staff member may return to campus.
- 6. If the test results are positive, the student, faculty or staff member must remain in quarantine and their return to campus date will be determined with the assistance of the Quinnipiack Valley Health District.
- 7. If a PCR test is not performed after the 5-7 day period, the student, faculty or staff member must complete a full 14 day quarantine period before they may return to campus.

(Note: This policy may be changed or modified based on new information provided by the State of Connecticut, Quinnipiack Valley Health District or the CDC)

Additionally, with the Flu season quickly approaching, we strongly suggest that you and your family members receive the Influenza Immunization this year for your additional safety.
