

Swimming Parent Code of Conduct



As a parent or guardian of a Zeus swimmer, we ask that you adhere to the following code of conduct:

Respect for All:

- ☐ Treat all team members, coaches, and officials with respect, regardless of their age, gender, race, ethnicity, religion, or ability.
- ☐ Avoid any form of harassment, bullying, or discriminatory behavior.
- ☐ Respect the decisions of officials and coaches.

Positive Sportsmanship:

- ☐ Encourage your child to be a positive role model, both in and out of the pool.
- ☐ Support all team members, regardless of their performance level.
- ☐ Avoid negative comments or behavior towards other swimmers, coaches, or officials.
- ☐ Emphasize the importance of effort, improvement, and having fun.

Communication:

- ☐ Communicate any concerns or issues with the coach in a respectful and timely manner.
- ☐ Avoid public criticism of coaches, officials, or other team members.
- ☐ Encourage your child to communicate directly with their coach about any concerns.
- ☐ Communication with coaches cannot be during practice or meets on the pool deck.
- ☐ Coaches may not be contacted after 8:00p.m. unless there is an emergency.

Team Support:

- ☐ Attend and participate in team events and volunteer when possible.
- ☐ Support team fundraising efforts and other team activities.
- ☐ Encourage your child to attend practices regularly and on time.

USA Swimming Rules and Regulations:

- ☐ Familiarize yourself with the USA Swimming Code of Conduct and Safe Sport Policy.
- ☐ Support USA Swimming's efforts to create a safe and positive environment for all athletes.
- ☐ Report any suspected abuse or misconduct to the appropriate authorities.
