Respect for All:

Avoid any form of harassment, bullying, or discriminatory behavior.	
Respect the decisions of officials and coaches.	
Positive Sportsmanship:	
☐ Encourage your child to be a positive role model, both in and out of the pool.	
☐ Support all team members, regardless of their performance level.	
Avoid negative comments or behavior towards other swimmers, coaches, or officials.	
☐ Emphasize the importance of effort, improvement, and having fun.	
Communication:	
☐ Communicate any concerns or issues with the coach in a respectful and timely	
manner.	
Avoid public criticism of coaches, officials, or other team members.	
☐ Encourage your child to communicate directly with their coach about any concerns.	
☐ Communication with coaches cannot be during practice or meets on the pool deck.	
☐ Coaches may not be contacted after 8:00p.m. unless there is an emergency.	
Feam Support:	
☐ Attend and participate in team events and volunteer when possible.	
☐ Support team fundraising efforts and other team activities.	
☐ Encourage your child to attend practices regularly and on time.
