LINDSEY McVEY DOLAN

Lindsey McVey Dolan was born and raised in Hot Springs, AR. She is a 1993 graduate of Lakeside High School and a 1997 graduate of the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville. She went on to receive her Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS) degree from the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry in 2000. Lindsey started swimming at age 8 at the Hot Springs YMCA and a few years later joined the Little Rock Racquet Club swim team under Head Coach Paul Blair.

She was the ASI JB Hunt Transport Age Group swimmer of the Year from 1989-1993 and the ASI JB Hunt Senior Swimmer of the Year 1991-1992. She was a member of the LRRC Regional and National teams receiving Swimmer of the Year honors throughout her high school career. As a 12-year-old, she won the Central Zone Championships in 100 Breaststroke and later went on to qualify and place in the top 3 multiple times. Lindsey qualified for Junior Nationals several times with a 3rd place finish in the 100m Breaststroke in 1991. As a 3-time High School State Champion in the 100 yd Breaststroke and 1-time Champion in the 50yd Freestyle for Lakeside High School, Lindsey was also named to the Scholastic All-American Team throughout her high school career. She was recognized by NISCA Top 16 award for the 100yd Breaststroke and 50yd Freestyle in 1992-93. Lindsey held state records for 13-14yo 100yd and 200yd Breaststroke, 1990 Open 100yd Breaststroke, 1991 15-18yo 100yd and 200m Breaststroke and Open 100yd and 100m Breaststroke. She went on to finish her distinguished swimming career as a member of the University of Arkansas Swimming and Diving Team receiving the University of Arkansas Athletics All Time Academic Champion honor in 1993 and SEC Academic Honor Roll honors in 1994-95.
