- 2) Senior Champs Jones Center- was the only bid received; the HYPR will not have locker rooms due to construction. Motion made and carried. None opposed.
  - a) Dates March 21-23, 2025- motion made by John Moseley; seconded by Tom; none opposed. Motion carried.
- Long Course Champs July 17-20- proposed date, which is the week after sectionals and 2 weeks before zones. John made a motion to approve; Tom seconded. No opposed. Motion carried.

 a) Location for Long Course Champs- Creekmore or Bentonville- vote take on a location for the meet. Bentonville received 6 votes; Creekmore received 16 votes. Long Course State will be at Ft. Smith's Creekmore pool.

<u>Approval of Rest of Planning Calendar</u>- draft available on the ARSI website. <u>John Moseley</u> made a motion to approve; Tom seconded; none opposed.

<u>Timing System Proposals</u> - Budget Change- John Moseley added that Central AR is getting 1 new touch pad, to pay for shipping, we should order 2 touch pads if we're paying for shipping already. <u>Jackie Bracey</u>made a motion to approve; Nathan Wardlow seconded; none opposed.
