- \* New rules May 1, listed in front of USAS rulebook
- \* When people send Ed sanction requests, all correspondence is with that representative. Dates listed in documents are specific for that meet, so if deadlines are not met, will lose deposit automatically. Dates are fixed in USAS rulebook!
- \* Most common mistake no longer 2015!
- \* Check rulebook citations for water depth and pool certification.
- \* Can charge \$2.60/event many teams still using \$2.50/event.
- \* Ed will strengthen sanction timeline process and penalties, important for teams to follow procedure.
- \* For sanction, if meet information is ready to go but there is no check or signed form, sanction # can't be issued
- \* If a team does not pay its bills to ASI on time, ASI can take away good standing. That means swimmers cannot swim as a club but can swim unattached.
- \* Clubs need to remember that they can be charged for swimmers who are put in to recon for meet but are not USAS registered.
- \* Club hosts need to be cautious about deck entries rules require swimmer to show proof of USAS registration. Meet information needs specific provision about on-deck registrations.
