- EXCEPTIONS
 - 50 Free awards for both genders will be awarded following the men's D heat
 - 1500 Free awards will be awarded before the Friday finals session
 - 800 Free awards will be awarded after the men's 800
 - Relay awards will be given at the beginning of the finals session the day they are swum, except for the 200 Medley and 400 Free Relays, which will be awarded Sunday morning at the conclusion of the prelims session.

Scratches

- Thursday events 1 hour prior to start of Thursday session (3:30 PM)
- Friday events 1 hour prior to the start of Friday events (8:00 AM)
- Saturday and Sunday events 30 minutes after the start of the finals session on the preceding day
- Finals 30 minutes after preliminary results are read
- Intent to scratch must declare intent within the 30 minute scratch timeframe following the reading of results; will have 30 minutes from the announcement of results from their final event to scratch either event.
- 800 Free session Sunday will be determined after the scratch deadline Saturday; pre-scratch, the estimated start time is 2:25 PM.

- No Shows
 - Prelims swimmer is out of future events for that day, except for finals already
 qualified for; swimmers must declare their intent to swim for subsequent days
 - Finals swimmers are barred from further competition in the meet, including relays
- DQs will attempt to post on the board, bave announced, and notify the swimmer
- Distance Events require positive check-in by scratch deadline to be seeded
- Swim-Offs coaches will be announced o report to Deck Ref o resolve any ties that determine the A, B, C, or D finalists, or any ties that would determine 1st or 2nd alternates for C or D finals

- Age restricted heats D final will be for 15-16 year olds only and any 14 year old that ages up before the AGS meet
- Admin Location Clerk of Course table will be under the scoreboard
