Job Expectations:

- Serves as Varsity Head Coach for K-12 program

- Develops aquatic programming for the center to include: classes, swim meets, tournaments, swim lessons, lap swimming, swim club and other aquatic programs as assigned.
- Assists in hiring, training and scheduling qualified lifeguards, instructors and all other pool staff; directly supervises lifeguards, instructors, and other aquatic staff.
- Conducts training of staff in water safety and ensures that all certifications of staff is maintained.
- Development of lifeguard deck rotational system for monitoring the pools and all other pool deck operations.
- Maintains proper pool chemical balance, handles the filtration system, and other aquatic operating systems with the assistance of the building maintenance CPO.
- Performs regular safety inspections of pools and equipment to reduce hazards and to provide maximum safety to the patrons.

- Experience in coaching swimming/diving
- Certified as Aquatics Facility Operator (APO) or Certified Pool Operator (CPO) preferred
