



2024 Unattached-Minnesota Registration Instructions & Payment Form (LSC Portion)

ALL registrations are initiated via the USA Swimming website.

Steps to register:

- 1) Log into your account
OR
Create your login on the USA Swimming website. www.hub.usaswimming.org/landing
(Members that were NOT members for the 2023 membership year are considered a new member and MUST Create a New Account.)
- 2) Link your old account with your new member account, if you were a member of USA Swimming prior to this year. This is done by either a) requesting your new ID via the system **OR** b) requesting the new ID by emailing Operations Manager, [Tracy Meece](mailto:Tracy.Meece@usaswimming.org)
- 3) Request the special UN-MN Registration link by emailing Operations Manager, [Tracy Meece](mailto:Tracy.Meece@usaswimming.org).
- 4) Use the special UN-MN registration link to register for 2024.
You will pay the USA Swimming portion of the fee DIRECTLY to USA Swimming at the time of registration.

Your membership is not in GOOD STANDING until all membership requirements for your membership type are completed. This includes but may not be limited to: Background Check, Athlete Protection Training, Concussion Protocol Training, Coach Education & Safety Requirements.
