Time Standards Meet

Type of Meet : Home Screen → Setup → Meet Setup → Type of Meet → Select Time Standards

Flag over-achievers with a “+”:

- Home Screen → Setup → Report Preferences → Report Formats Tab → Flag Over-achievers with a “+”
- Time Standards need to be included in report.

 - Flag Over-Achievers with a "+"
 - Flag Under-Achievers with a "-"
 - 12 and Under as Under 13
 - 13, 15, or 17 and Over as Senior / Open
 - Display military time
 - Relays as 4x100 and 4x200 style
 - Relays alt with 2 fastest heats 1st (obsolete; by session now)
- Paper Size - Meet Program / Results:**
 - 8 1/2 x 11
 - 8 1/2 x 14
 - A4

Time Standards Meet

Separate results by division (A,B, etc....):

- Home Screen → Setup → Entry/Scoring Preferences → Scoring/Awards Tab → check Different point system for each Division

Configure how many awards per division (ex. 6 places or 8 places? 3 places for relays?):

- Home Screen → Setup → Entry/Scoring Preferences → Scoring/Awards Tab → Enter appropriate # under Individual and Relay for “Top how many award labels”.
- NOTE: This is overridden by the Award Label screen if there is another award label number filled in on that screen.



Time Standards Meet

Points awarded by seed time:

- Home Screen → Setup → Entry/Scoring Preferences → Time Stds Meet Tab → select:
 - Points awarded based on Seed Time
 - Points and awards given to Over achievers
 - Points and awards given to Under achievers

Time Standards Meet

Identify how seed times are to be grouped for awards and scoring:

- Home Screen → Events → Standards
 - Create time standard tag with no times. To be used for slower than B seeds.
 - At the bottom of the screen create a new tag → name = CRST → leave “For Time Standards” unchecked.
 - In the scoring column check the standards that should be grouped.
 - A/B/C Open = A,B, CRST checked
 - A/B Open = A, B checked
 - Note: Standard Meet = all standards are unchecked
 - The Entry Qual column is used when a meet has minimum/maximum qualifications.
 - A/B/C Open = “PREC” is checked
 - MRC Meet with minimum of B/but less than CH = CH and B are checked

1) TIME STANDARDS are used to flag times on Heat Sheets, Psych Sheets, and Results.
 2) ENTRY QUALIFICATION times are used to help with data entry. Please read the Help for details on how to setup and use entry qualification times.
 3) Tags for SCORING are only used in Timed Final events when the meet is set-up as Divisions by Time Standards. Be sure to go to Set-up/Entry Scoring Preferences to specify your Time Std scoring rules. To specify a 'slowest' category such as C, create a C tag with no time standard times.

Time Standards Meet

Defining points for scoring the meet:

- Home Screen → Setup → Scoring setup → Standard
 - Select the time standard at the bottom of the page.
 - Click “default” to reset the points to default
 - Enter number of places to score.
 - Enter 1 if the meet is not scored. In the scoring system window set 2 and 4 to 0.
 - Click Ok.
 - Repeat for each time standard
