

Minnesota Swimming Uniform Guidelines

Updated February 2024

Minnesota Swimming officials are expected to appear as a team while on deck! Below is the preferred uniform for officials at Minnesota Swimming sanctioned and approved meets:

- **Shirt:** A white or pink polo shirt or collared shirt should be worn. A pink polo shirt is especially encouraged on Sunday. A tucked in shirt is preferred. Shirts with club logos are discouraged. The shirt color worn is subject to the discretion of the Meet Referee (for example, at some championship meets, only white shirts are worn on certain days for uniformity).
- Pants: Black shorts, skirt, or pants should be worn. Athletic/gym shorts and sweatpants are not permitted.
- **Shoes:** Predominantly black tennis shoes or sneakers should be worn. Crocs, flip flops, and sandals are discouraged.
- Modifications to Uniform: This uniform may be altered at the discretion of the Meet Referee
 with the concurrence of the host club such as requiring long pants for finals sessions, or to suit
 weather conditions.
