- d. Discussion was had on the addition of B finals and number of individual events
 - i. Athlete Representatives stated they would be in support of decreasing the number of individual events from seven to six
 - ii. Lisa Montplaisir made a motion to add a B final for all age groups
 - 1. Chris Domitrovich seconds
 - 2. Brian Toay proposed an amendment be added that number of individual events per athletes be decreased to six
 - a. Chris Domitrovich approved and second
 - 3. Motion passed



- e. Discussion on relays in regards to abundance of categories, time duration, and qualifying standards
 - i. Athlete Representatives shared they enjoyed mixed relays
- f. Confirmed the Hulbert Aquatic Center can run a dual pool for the mile
 - i. All 20 lanes would be able to have splits shown on the scoreboard
 - ii. It would be up to the Meet Referee if the 500 and 1000 freestyle, in addition to the 800 free relay, would be swam in dual pool format
 - iii. Athlete Representatives shared they supported the idea of running dual pools for the mile. Similarly, they supported a dual pool set up, verses having a competition pool and cross pool
- g. State Meet Committee will present a revised order of events at Fall HOD to be voted on
- h. Start time was a recurring topic that received constructive feedback in the survey
 - i. Suggestions were have Finals start earlier when needing to return for warm-ups at 7am
 - ii. Noted that start time will depend on number of entries, thus it is possible Prelim start time could be pushed back and Finals could start earlier while still having the same break
- 9. Policy 6.9 Policy Revision (continued)
 - a. Additional discussion was had
 - b. Ben Richards made a motion to keep 15-16 and 17-18 age groups for LC season and LC State Meet
 - i. Amy Mayer second
 - ii. Motion passed
 - c. Before voting to adopt the revised policy and remove Policies 6.4-5 and 6.7-12, Jill Schlenker and Rachel Carter will ensure all current policies are accounted for in the proposed revised policy
 - i. BOD in agreeance that upon verification, Rachel Carter will email revised policy proposal, with SC and LC State Meet subsections, with a motion to approve, before the HOD meeting

10. Additional topics

- a. Athlete registration fees
 - i. Should be submitted to USA Swimming in May, thus need to discuss at Spring HOD
 - ii. Discussion had on increasing registration fees
 - iii. Lisa Montplaisir motioned to increase athlete registration fees by \$5.00, thus bringing registration fees to \$15.00
 - 1. Jill Schlenker second
 - a. Brian Toay proposed an amendment of updating the athlete registration fee to \$15.00 and non-athlete registration fee to \$8.00 for 2026 in Policy 2.1
 - Lisa Montplaisir accepted the addition of Brian Toay's amendment with additional amendment to bring current the USA swimming registration fees
 - 1. Brian Toay accepted Lisa Montplaisir's additional amendment
 - 2. Motion passed



- iv. Kim Kuntz made a motion remove to Policy 2.2.A.1, and the addition of "and reduced" between the words 'free' and 'lunch' to read: "...federal free and reduced lunch guidelines..."
 - 1. Brian Toay proposed an amendment to Policy 2.2A, with addition of "LSC fiscal" be inserted between 'per' and 'year' to read: "... \$250 per LSC fiscal year, per swimmer
 - a. Kim Kuntz accepted Brian Toay's amendment
 - 2. Lisa Montplaisir second
 - 3. Motion passed
