Children's Online Privacy Protection Act Policy (COPPA)



In order to comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), North Dakota Swimming Inc. adheres to the following policies regarding its website.

North Dakota Swimming Inc. has only one person authorized to collect and publish the full name, home address, email address, telephone number or any other information ("Identifying Information") about a child on its website at any given time that would allow someone to identify or contact the child. That person can be contacted directly, with any parental concerns, at ndlscswimming@gmail.com with a copy to the General Chair at ndlsc.generalchair@gmail.com.

North Dakota Swimming Inc. does not permit advertising on its website for events or causes, which charge a fee or require purchase or membership signup, other than those programs sponsored by USA Swimming or North Dakota Swimming Inc.

No Identifying Information is collected on the North Dakota Swimming Inc. website that would allow someone to identify or contact a child.

North Dakota Swimming Inc. does not permit the posting of pictures on its website that contain more than two types of Identifying Information.

North Dakota Swimming Inc. does not use social media, chat rooms, or similar Internet forums, through its website that could result in the release of Identifying Information.

North Dakota Swimming Inc. does not collect identifiable tracking information such as "cookies".

No Identifying Information from a child, will be collected by North Dakota Swimming Inc., used or disclosed by North Dakota Swimming Inc. without verifiable parental consent.

North Dakota Swimming Inc. does not disclose to any third parties, other than USA Swimming, Identifying Information regarding its members. This includes the news media and marketing.

Parents may request that any posted photograph, or any other information, be removed from the North Dakota Swimming website if they feel it is too identifiable.

North Dakota Swimming Inc. and its clubs do use information collected regarding children in the course of administering the sport of competitive swimming in North Dakota. For registration purposes, information is transmitted to USA Swimming, the national governing body of swimming.
