6. Summer Senior Meet '14
 - Teams from Canada and LE coming to the meet.
 - Meet entry deadline is July 17th. Not using OME for the meet.
 - Top 3 finishers are awarded
 - Special Event for Summer 2014: Mixed 200 med/free relays: 2 males/2 females
7. Spring Senior Meet '15
 - Meet in Oxford
 - Proposal to have a D heat for college athletes only, and preserve the A, B, and C heats for the non-collegiate athletes. Idea was well received by the group. 19 & over unattached would be categorized with the collegiate swimmers. Run relays as is, but score them separately. Give awards out right after college heat finishes. Swum D-C-B-A (college heat)
 - Proposed changes to the Senior Meet events:
 1. Swap 400 IM with 200 Fly
 2. Swap 50 Free and 200 IM (put 50 Free between 200 IM and 100 Breast)
8. Reimbursement Program Needs Attention
 - Committee to look at promoting more teams to attend higher level meets. Help subsidize smaller clubs to help send a coach with their athlete. Chris, John, Jason, Ed, Kyle on committee.
 - Reimbursement form to be reviewed and conditions of reimbursement to be re-evaluated. With changes in USA Swimming championship meets, the document will have to be re-looked at.
9. National Qualifiers Numbers (see heat maps)
 - Some possible meet re-structuring in the National circuit: Winter Jr Nationals possibly being broken into 2 meets in 2015; drop "Jr National" name, "junior championships" instead; a single Grand Prix meet during the winter; time standards will not change for winter championship meets; jr nationals will be a SCY meet



with LCM time trials. During LC, single national champions; single jr national meet; addition of “Legends” meets which will be 2.5% slower than jr cuts (between sectionals and jr nationals), meet will be held during jr national week; Legends meets named after swimming legends; sectionals will be 2 weeks before Legends meets; OH will be in the Legends region with Mid-Atlantic, North Carolina, Virginia, Niagara, etc. per the heat map.

- Swimming numbers are still increasing vs other sports. Surge in 13-15 age group.
