Re: Administrative Vice Chair Report to the BOD

OSI Mission – Ohio Swimming provides leadership and support to coaches, volunteers and swim programs that maximize every swimmer's potential for excellence.

Here is the proposed language for the Governance Committee to include in the Code of Regulations for the Fall 2018 HOD meeting.

3. GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE -

- A. CHAIR The chair shall be elected annually by the Governance Committee from among its own members.
- B. MEMBERS The Administrative Vice Chair shall have voice but no vote on the Governance Committee. The Governance Committee members shall be appointed by the General Chair with advice and consent of the Board of Directors. The Committee shall be comprised of members of OSI in good standing, have at least some experience in Board operations, and have at least one member from each of OSI's commissions with at least one of them being a coach member, and with a sufficient number of athletes so as to constitute at least twenty percent (20%) of the voting membership of the Committee. Each member shall serve a four-*year* term, staggered so that *one-fourth* (1/4) of such members are appointed each year. No more than one-half (1/2) of the Governance Committee members shall be members of the OSI Board of Directors at any given time. After completion of two consecutive terms, members are not eligible for re-appointment to the Governance Committee until after a lapse of two years. A portion of any term served to fill a vacancy in the position shall not be considered in the computation of the successive term limitation. In no case shall the General Chair serve on the Governance Committee.
- C. QUORUM When making nominations, a quorum for any meeting of the Governance Committee shall consist of a majority of its voting members. For all other meetings, a quorum shall consist of those members present and voting.

D. DUTIES

- (1) To assist in periodic evaluation of the mission and vision statements and the Bylaws of OSI;
- (2) To aid in the development of operating policies regarding conflict of interest (Board and staff), document retention, ethics, whistle-blower, procurement, contract review, grievance and other employment-related practices, etc.;
- (3) To aid in the development of personnel practices procedure including job descriptions and annual review of staff;
- (4) To ensure that the Board's focus remains on the strategic plan;
- (5) To aid in the development of expectations and processes for accountability of Board members;
- (6) To develop criteria for the qualities and required characteristics of Board officers;
- (7) To lead Board succession planning by assessing current and anticipated needs for Board composition and identifying and recruiting potential Board members;
- (8) To nominate Board members, Administrative Review Board members, and other coordinator or chair positions to be elected by the House of Delegates consistent with the matrix of skills, demographics, and talents needed;
- (9) To publish the slate of candidates to the OSI membership at least *twenty (20)* days prior to the election. Additional nominations may be made from the floor of the House of Delegates by voting members of the House of Delegates;
- (10) To design and implement Board orientation and an ongoing program of Board education and development; and
- (11) To lead periodic assessment of the Board's performance (as a whole and of individual members) and make recommendations to enhance Board effectiveness.

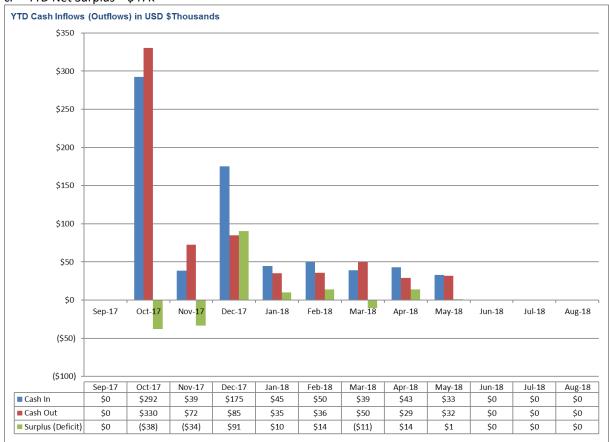

3. Other Matters

- a. Budget Process: The budget planning process is underway with initial budget requests due to the Budget Committee by June 24, 2018. Important: for any significant new proposals, new programs, or substantial changes from prior year authorized budgets, please confirm that any such significant changes have appropriate policy approval from the BOD. The June BOD meeting will be the ideal opportunity to raise any such items prior to submitting the initial budget request. Interested parties are invited to attend Budget Committee meetings to share information on any such approved new initiatives/substantial changes.
- b. Senior Travel Fund: Out of a budget of \$19K for the year, \$22.4K has been reimbursed to athletes year-to-date. \$3.6K relates to prior year reimbursements processed after August 31st. We will be overspent in this category in comparison to budget, compared to a pattern of underspending in prior years. We will continue to monitor reimbursements during long course season, and this new trend and potential impact on future year budgets will be discussed on the June BOD call.
- c. Team Unify update: FY18 Registrations receivables are approximately \$26K receivables as of May 31, 2018 (improved from approximately \$48K receivables as of May 31, 2017). The Treasurer/OSI Staff continue to follow up on significant receivables in the > 60 day aging category. The use of Team Unify has significantly improved the registration process and tracking and follow-up of outstanding amounts is much easier utilizing technology.
