Todd B called the meeting to order at 8:02pm.

- 1. Approve Agenda Motion was made and unanimously carried to Approve Agenda.
- 2. Consent Agenda
 - a. Adoption December 2021 BOD Minutes **Motion was made and unanimously carried to Approve December 2021 BOD Minutes.**
 - b. January 2022 Treasurer's Report David L reviewed his report. See attached report for details. Joe W added that he has received the Form 990 report for review. He will present it to the board after he reviews it. Once it is approved by the board, David L will sign and send it to the IRS.
- 3. Committee Reports / Discussions
 - a. January 2022 General Chair Report Todd B. Todd B stated that Kathy Fish was unable to attend our meeting due to a conflict but plans to attend our February meeting instead. If anyone has questions for her, please send those to Todd B. Since she could not attend this month's meeting, Todd shared her answers to a few questions that he had posed to her. What has been the impact of the flex membership? It really has not been successful in driving membership, but that Age Group Development Committee is working on strategic ideas such as shorter and more frequent meets to support kids that do not want to practice as much. Has membership rebounded since COVID began? Membership is still down but is rebounding faster than the board and staff expected. The long term strategy is to create more partnerships with clubs and continue to use flex membership (perhaps with revisions). More details are to come. Is USA-S happy with the investment in the DEI part of the program? Kathy said that it is hard to assess due to COVID, but she will share more specifics in February. Regarding the issue of fairness for female athletes and the recent transgender athlete situation that has garnered much media attention, USA-S is getting ready to come out with an official statement that is going to be more supportive of fairness for female athletes, and they are trying to push this down to the HS level. It is with the USOPC and has also gone to FINA. There will be more to come on that subject. Todd B also met with the athlete representatives to pin down their project for the year. They are planning a water safety day/clinic in underserved areas and are considering the April/May timeframe. The goal is to reach as many commissions as possible. They will need help from athlete volunteers across the LSC and are looking for connections in the Columbus, Dayton and Toledo areas with teams that have underserved athletes. They need leads. Erin S asked if pools are needed. Todd B intends to ask UC and possibly BGSU. Partnerships are needed to keep costs low. Athletes also came up with some ideas

for 10U session of JO's.

- b. Governance Committee Member BOD Vote Steve C. presented Edgar Carabello and Clare Kemmere to the board for addition to the Governance Committee. Both candidates were unanimously approved for membership on the Governance Committee.
- Age Group Committee Report and 2022 JO Time Standards Kevin R. and Erin S. Erin S reported that the 100 IM standard for short course meters was missing from the document. She mentioned that it should be on the website, but if not, it will be posted tomorrow. Terry A asked when the meet book information for JO's will be posted. Erin S said it was near completion and would send it to Terry for additional review. Kevin R reviewed the AGC report since it was not distributed (inadvertently) to the board prior to the meeting. The committee report details the plans, locations and meet hosts for the upcoming regional and JO meets. The JO meet will be split between Mason and Cincinnati by age group. The JO time standards were loosened to ensure that the correct number of swimmers will compete in the meet. John M mentioned his concern about having two JO meets in Cincinnati since it would put NW at disadvantage due to distance. Kevin R explained further that the 10U and 11-14 are in separate facilities but both are in the Cincinnati area to help coaches and families that have athletes in both age groups. The two sites are within 22-23 minutes of each other. The meet schedule may also be moved up on Sunday to support those traveling from a distance. BGSU was considered for the meet when OSU had cancelled, but it was not possible due to the MAC championships. Brent P commended the committee regarding the JO standard adjustment and qualifying swimmer estimates but shared a concern that too many swimmers may make the new standard and inflate timelines. Lew T raised a concern that the committee could be violating a long standing LSC policy that prohibited JO time standards from getting slower. Carolyn S also recalled this policy and provided some age group committee history on the matter. She mentioned that the standards were in place to ensure a certain number of swimmers in the JO meets but that the AGC had never allowed the standards to get slower. Todd B also recalled this policy and said that he thought it was recorded in the "gray book". Lew T explained that the rationale for the policy was that since national standards never get slower, neither should those in Ohio. Kevin R and Brent P substantiated that the AGC had to lower standards this year to keep swimmers excited about swimming and to ensure enough swimmers would qualify for the meet. Erin S will consult her copy of the "gray book" for this policy and will consider adding a statement to the meet information to explain that OSI chose to slow the time standards due to the pandemic to allow more athletes into the meet and that OSI intends to return to the 2019 standards (or faster) after this year (or once the pandemic subsides). Motion was made and unanimously carried to accept the proposed 2022 JO time standards.

4. OSI Strategic Plan

- a. Mission and Vision Survey Mark K. shared a survey that was prepared by the previous Governance Committee about 2 years ago but was put aside when the pandemic began. The GC would like to move forward with the survey now, starting with head coaches. Getting feedback from OSI constituents, particularly regarding DEI, will be helpful for strategic planning. He would like to possibly send out the survey prior to JO's so that results could be shared at the HOD. The survey is focused on our ADMIRE values. Mark K requested feedback from the board regarding the survey idea and its timing. Terry A asks that the DEI question be enhanced to find out how clubs define DEI and to ask what the board can do to help. He suggested that we need to understand the baseline, especially because he suspects that clubs are in different places. He also asked if ADMIRE (vision) is truly reflective of where we are today as an LSC and suggested that it might be time to refresh that. Steve suggested that we may also want to consider surveying team board presidents. John M wondered if something should be sent out to the membership, so they know what the board is doing. Todd B mentioned that the results of survey could be summarized and sent out. He also mentioned that he would like to send out the survey prior to the championship meets so that the board can personally ask coaches to complete it.

Re: OSI Treasurer's Report

- 1. Financials as of and for the three months ended December 31, 2021 (period 3)
 - a. Net revenue of \$85,680 compared to \$60,750 due to higher registrations offset by delayed collections and higher meet fees. Athlete registrations collected are up 46% over prior year. Meet fees were 161% higher than prior year.
 - b. Outflows of \$67,060 compared to \$64,957. Increase is due to budgeted increases in permanent office costs, timing of payments of certain expenses and senior meet awards.
 - c. Our suprlus for the YTD period was \$18,621, compared to a deficit of \$4,207 in the prior year.

2. Other Matters

- a. Outstanding A/R as of January 19th was \$144,813, down from \$158,874 last month. Amounts overdue past 90 days total \$1,567, also down from \$2,178 last month. There is only one club with an overdue balance > \$1,000 (and then only barely).
- b. Balance Sheet and Reserves: We continue to be in a very strong balance sheet position with excess reserves of approximately \$73,500. This number is higher than prior month because year-end dividend and capital gains distributions increased the cost basis of many of our investments.
